God the Father, 14

John 6:27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath **God the Father** sealed.

1 Corinthians 8:6 But to us there is but one **God, the Father**, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

Galatians 1:1 Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and **God the Father**, who raised him from the dead;)

Galatians 1:3 Grace be to you and peace from **God the Father**, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

Ephesians 6:23 Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from **God the Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 2:11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of **God the Father**.

Malachi 2:10 Have we not all one father? hath not **one God** created us? why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?

Mark 12:32 And the scribe said unto him [Christ], Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is **one God**; and there is none other but he.

Romans 3:30 Seeing it is **one God**, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

1 Corinthians 8:6 But to us there is but **one God**, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

Ephesians 4:6 **One God** and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

2 Chronicles 15:3 Now for a long season Israel hath been without the **true God**, and without a teaching priest, and without law.

Jeremiah 10:10 But the LORD is the **true God**, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

John 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only **true God**, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

1 Thessalonians 1:9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and **true God**.

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the **true God**, and eternal life.

Living God, 30

Deuteronomy 5:26 For who is there of all flesh, that hath heard the voice of the **living God** speaking out of the midst of the fire, as we have, and lived?

Joshua 3:10 And Joshua said, Hereby ye shall know that the **living God** is among you, and that he will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Hivites, and the Perizzites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Jebusites.

1 Samuel 17:26 And David spake to the men that stood by him, saying, What shall be done to the man that killeth this Philistine, and taketh away the reproach from Israel? for who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the **living God**?

1 Samuel 17:36 Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the **living God**.

2 Kings 19:4 It may be the LORD thy God will hear all the words of Rabshakeh, whom the king of Assyria his master hath sent to reproach the **living God**; and will reprove the words which the LORD thy God hath heard: wherefore lift up thy prayer for the remnant that are left.

2 Kings 19:16 LORD, bow down thine ear, and hear: open, LORD, thine eyes, and see: and hear the words of Sennacherib, which hath sent him to reproach the **living God**.

Psalms 42:2 My soul thirsteth for God, for the **living God**: when shall I come and appear before God?

Psalms 84:2 My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the LORD: my heart and my flesh crieth out for the **living God**.

Isaiah 37:4 It may be the LORD thy God will hear the words of Rabshakeh, whom the king of Assyria his master hath sent to reproach the **living God**, and will reprove the words which the LORD thy God hath heard: wherefore lift up thy prayer for the remnant that is left.

Isaiah 37:17 Incline thine ear, O LORD, and hear; open thine eyes, O LORD, and see: and hear all the words of Sennacherib, which hath sent to reproach the **living God**.

Jeremiah 10:10 But the LORD is the true God, he is the **living God**, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

Jeremiah 23:36 And the burden of the LORD shall ye mention no more: for every man's word shall be his burden; for ye have perverted the words of the **living God**, of the LORD of hosts our God.

Daniel 6:20 And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the **living God**, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions?

Daniel 6:26 I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the **living God**, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end.

Hosea 1:10 Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people, there it shall be said unto them, Ye are the sons of the **living God**.

Matthew 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the **living God**.

Matthew 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the **living God**, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

John 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the **living God**.

Acts 14:15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the **living God**, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein:

Romans 9:26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the **living God**.

2 Corinthians 3:3 Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the **living God**; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.

2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the **living God**; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

1 Timothy 3:15 But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the **living God**, the pillar and ground of the truth.

1 Timothy 4:10 For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the **living God**, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.

1 Timothy 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the **living God**, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;

Hebrews 3:12 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the **living God**.

Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the **living God**?

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the **living God**.

Hebrews 12:22 But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the **living God**, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

Revelation 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the **living God**: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea.

God of Abraham, 17

Genesis 26:24 And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the **God of Abraham** thy father: fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Genesis 28:13 And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I am the LORD **God of Abraham** thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

Genesis 31:42 Except the God of my father, the **God of Abraham**, and the fear of Isaac, had been with me, surely thou hadst sent me away now empty. God hath seen mine affliction and the labour of my hands, and rebuked thee yesternight.

Genesis 31:53 The **God of Abraham**, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Exodus 3:6 Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 3:15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

Exodus 3:16 Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the **God of Abraham**, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and seen that which is done to you in Egypt:

Exodus 4:5 That they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee.

1 Kings 18:36 And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word.

1 Chronicles 29:18 O LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

2 Chronicles 30:6 So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Psalms 47:9 The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the **God of Abraham**: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Matthew 22:32 I am the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

Mark 12:26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I am the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

Luke 20:37 Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Acts 3:13 The **God of Abraham**, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

Acts 7:32 Saying, I am the God of thy fathers, the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Lord of Heaven and Earth, 3

Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, **Lord of heaven and earth**, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

Luke 10:21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, **Lord of heaven and earth**, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

Acts 17:24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is **Lord of heaven and earth**, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

My Father, 55 (New Testament)

Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 8:21 And another of his disciples said unto him, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury **my father**.

Matthew 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 10:33 But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 11:27 All things are delivered unto me of **my Father**: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him.

Matthew 12:50 For whosoever shall do the will of **my Father** which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.

Matthew 16:17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of **my Father** which is in heaven.

Matthew 20:23 And he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of **my Father**.

Matthew 24:36 But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but **my Father** only.

Matthew 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of **my Father**, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Matthew 26:39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O **my Father**, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

Matthew 26:42 He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O **my Father**, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.

Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to **my Father**, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

Luke 9:59 And he said unto another, Follow me. But he said, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury **my father**.

Luke 10:22 All things are delivered to me of **my Father**: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him.

Luke 15:18 I will arise and go to **my father**, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,

Luke 22:29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as **my Father** hath appointed unto me;

Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of **my Father** upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

John 5:17 But Jesus answered them, **My Father** worketh hitherto, and I work.

John 6:32 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but **my Father** giveth you the true bread from heaven.

John 6:65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of **my Father**.

John 8:19 Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor **my Father**: if ye had known me, ye should have known **my Father** also.

John 8:28 Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as **my Father** hath taught me, I speak these things.

John 8:38 I speak that which I have seen with **my Father**: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

John 8:49 Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour **my Father**, and ye do dishonour me.

John 8:54 Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is **my Father** that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

John 10:17 Therefore doth **my Father** love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

John 10:18 No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of **my Father**.

John 10:29 **My Father**, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of **my Father's** hand.

John 10:30 I and **my Father** are one.

John 10:32 Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from **my Father**; for which of those works do ye stone me?

John 10:37 If I do not the works of **my Father**, believe me not.

John 12:26 If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will **my Father** honour.

John 14:7 If ye had known me, ye should have known **my Father** also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto **my Father**.

John 14:20 At that day ye shall know that I am in **my Father**, and ye in me, and I in you.

John 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of **my Father**, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and **my Father** will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

John 14:28 Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for **my Father** is greater than I.

John 15:1 I am the true vine, and **my Father** is the husbandman.

John 15:8 Herein is **my Father** glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

John 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of **my Father** I have made known unto you.

John 15:23 He that hateth me hateth **my Father** also.

John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and **my Father**.

John 16:10 Of righteousness, because I go to **my Father**, and ye see me no more;

John 18:11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which **my Father** hath given me, shall I not drink it?

John 20:17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to **my Father**: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto **my Father**, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

John 20:21 Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as **my Father** hath sent me, even so send I you.

Revelation 2:27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of **my Father**.

Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before **my Father**, and before his angels.

Revelation 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with **my Father** in his throne.
