## The World History

The Bible has accurately prophesied the succession of empires, past and present. Jesus revealed the course of his life and death to his disciples, saying; "And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe" John 14:29. And 2 Timothy 3:16 tells us that the holy scriptures "are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." Prophecy is meant for instruction, correction, reproof and doctrine. This study will explore one biblical prophecy of many.

*Opening prayer:* Wise and Holy Father, reveal to us through Your word, those things that were foretold in Daniel's day and through the prophets of old. We ask for spiritual minds to understand and believe Your words to us, Your people. You are not a secretive God; and bring us always what we need for wisdom and faith. We pray in the wonderful name of Jesus Christ, amen.

Using the King James Bible, read each verse, filling in the missing words. What had God foretold and revealed to his servants?

1. Daniel 2:1-3 "And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar dreamed
wherewith his spirit was and his sleep brake from him. Then the king commanded
to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to the king his
dreams. So they came and stood before the king."
Reading on (Daniel 2: 4-49) we see that the king's men were unable to interpret the dream.
The king decreed that the wise men should be slain. Daniel, a believer in God, was a captive
in the king's service at the time. When he learned of the decree, he asked to assist the king by
interpreting the dream. When Nebuchadnezzar agreed, Daniel requested a little time. Daniel and
his friends spent time in prayer, asking God to reveal to them the meaning of the dream.

Rome, legs of iron, 168 B.C. – A.D. 476. The Divided Empire, feet of iron and clay, no single power has ruled since AD 476.
