of 28 The Bible has accurately prophesied the succession of empires, past and present. Jesus revealed the course of his life and death to his disciples, saying; "And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe" John 14:29. And 2 Timothy 3:16 tells us that the holy scriptures "are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." Prophecy is meant for instruction, correction, reproof and doctrine. This study will explore one biblical prophecy of many.

Using the King James Bible, read each verse, filling in the missing words. What had God foretold and revealed to his servants?

1. *Daniel 2:1-3* "And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar dreamed ______wherewith his spirit was ______ and his sleep brake from him. Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to _____ the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king."

Reading on (Daniel 2: 4-49) we see that the king's men were unable to interpret the dream. The king decreed that the wise men should be slain. Daniel, a believer in God, was a captive in the king's service at the time. When he learned of the decree, he asked to assist the king by interpreting the dream. When Nebuchadnezzar agreed, Daniel requested a little time. Daniel and his friends spent time in prayer, asking God to reveal to them the meaning of the dream.

Daniel repeated the dream to the King, Daniel 2:32-35. Then he proceeded to interpret the dream to the king as God had revealed it to him, Daniel 2:36-45

Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out _______ hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and ______ them to pieces. Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the ______ of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place

was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great _____, and filled the whole earth."

History defines these kingdoms: Babylon, head of gold, 612-539 B.C. | Medo-Persia, breast and thighs of silver, 539-331 B.C. | Greece, belly and thighs of brass, 331-168 B.C. | Rome, legs of iron, 168 B.C. – A.D. 476. The Divided Empire, feet of iron and clay, no single power has ruled since AD 476.
