## The Heavenly Sanctuary

The Old Testament contains plans for an earthly sanctuary, which was built to God's exact specifications. A heavenly sanctuary is mentioned in both the Old and New Testaments. What is their significance? Why was God so exacting in his specifications; why was it needed on earth; and does it really exist in heaven? Is the message still relevant today?

*Opening prayer:* Lord of All, thank You for Your clear word. As we delve into this topic, show us its significance; connect the message there to our lives and our eternal salvation. You do nothing that is trivial, that is not for our better good. Bring us understanding through this study so we see the bigger picture of Your plan and how you are striving to save us. In the name of Jesus Christ we pray, amen.

Using the King James Bible, read each verse, filling in the missing words. What does each verse tell us of God and his Gospel message?

1. <i>Hebrews 12:24-25</i> "And to Jesus the mediator of the covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh things than that of Abel. See that ye refuse not him that speaketh."
2. <i>Psalms 102:19</i> "For he hath looked down from the height of his; from did the Lord behold the earth;"
3. <i>Hebrews 8:1-5</i> "Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A of the sanctuary, and of the tabernacle, which the pitched, and not man. For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer. For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law: Who serve unto the and shadow of things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount. But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better, which was established upon better"
4. <i>Hebrews 9:22-23</i> "And almost all things are by the law purged with; and without shedding of blood is no"
5. Daniel 8:14 "And he said unto me, Unto thousand and hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be"
6. <i>Acts 3:19-21</i> " ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; and he shall Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began."

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7. Revelation 15:5-8 "And after that I looked, and behold, the temple of the of the testimon in heaven was: And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed is pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were"
To understand the process of the earthly sanctuary, read Leviticus, chapter 16. The service was a type or shadow of the plan of salvation prior to Jesus' incarnation, death and resurrection. There is much more that could be said about the sanctuary service as it has deep meaning and deserves a lesson of its own.
Revelation 16 depicts the finishing work just prior to the advent of Christ. It requires deeper study to apply the symbols and acquire a deeper understanding. Reading it now would provide an overview, create a curiosity for God's word and acknowledgement of the continuity of language throughout the Bible.
