

Son of God Questions

(duplicate verses may be skipped for the sake of redundancy)

Daniel 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the [Son of God](#).

- **Question:** *How could the heathen king had known about God having a Son except the faithful Hebrews would have told him the truth about that fact? (As an aside, this chapter is parallel with the end time chapter of Revelation 13:11-18.)*

Matthew 4:3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the [Son of God](#), command that these stones be made bread.

- **Question:** *If the devil knew that the phrase “Son of God” didn’t belong to Christ, wouldn’t he have used that as a tool to destroy the reputation and influence of Christ during His ministry on earth?*

Matthew 4:6 And saith unto him, If thou be the [Son of God](#), cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in *their* hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.

- **Question:** *Why did the enemy mention that God would send angels to protect Christ as the Son of God? Why didn’t the devil mention God sending something or someone else?*

Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou [Son of God](#)? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?

- **Question:** *These were demons speaking, so why did they address Jesus as the “Son of God?” Could that harken back to before the fall when they were all in heaven together?*

Matthew 14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the [Son of God](#).

- **Question:** *The storm had just been calmed, so why did the disciples call Jesus the “Son of God” rather than “God” in this situation?*

Matthew 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the [Son of God](#).

- **Question:** *What was Christ’s first two words in answer to this question in Mark 14:62? “I am.”*

Matthew 27:40 And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest *it* in three days, save thyself. If thou be the [Son of God](#), come down from the cross.

- **Question:** *What greater temptations could there have been? Jesus was the Son of God, and He did want to come down from the cross!*

Matthew 27:43 He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *What greater taunting could there have been in this situation? They were making it seem like Christ's claim of being the Son of God was false, using proof that it was false because God, His Father, hadn't delivered Him.*

Matthew 27:54 Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *Could heathen see beyond what God's church on earth could in this situation?*

Mark 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the **Son of God**;

- **Question:** *Did Mark know who he was writing about?*

Mark 3:11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *How did the unclean spirits know that Jesus was the "Son of God?"*

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *Was the angel here referring to the combination of both the human and the divine nature of Jesus, the Son of God?*

Luke 3:38 Which was the son of Enos, which was the son of Seth, which was the son of Adam, which was the **son of God**.

- **Question:** *Are there more than one way to understand the phrase "son of God" in the Bible? Could it be that there are sons by creation [angels], sons adopted [sinners], and an only begotten Son of God [Jesus]?*

Luke 4:41 And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the **Son of God**. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

- **Question:** *If the devils knew that Christ was NOT the Son of God, wouldn't they have called Him out as an imposter?*

Luke 8:28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou **Son of God** most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.

- **Question:** *Who is Jesus, according to this fallen angel, the Son of? (Answer: God most high.)*

Luke 22:70 Then said they all, Art thou then the **Son of God**? And he said unto them, **Ye say that I am.**

- **Question:** *Did the devils know more than the church on earth about Jesus Christ?*

John 1:34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the **Son of God.**

- **Question:** *Did John the Baptist give a prophet's report, did he bear record, or give witness, that Jesus is "the Son of God?"*

John 1:49 Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the **Son of God**; thou art the King of Israel.

- **Question:** *If the news of the day was that God didn't have a Son, why was it that those seeking for the coming Messiah openly confessed that Jesus was God's Son?*

John 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten **Son of God.**

- **Question:** *Was it important, according to him "whom Jesus loved," that Jesus was the Son of God?*

John 5:25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the **Son of God**: and they that hear shall live.

- **Question:** *Did Jesus speak of Himself as the "Son of God" in the grammatical third person?*

John 9:35 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the **Son of God**?

- **Question:** *If this subject was of little importance, why did Christ ask this as the first question?*

John 10:36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the **Son of God**?

- **Question:** *According to this wording, when chronologically did the Father sanctify His Son?*

John 11:4 When Jesus heard *that*, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the **Son of God** might be glorified thereby.

- **Question:** *What glorifies the Son of God?*

John 11:27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the **Son of God**, which should come into the world.

- **Question:** *Did Jesus correct one of his closest disciples when she stated that He was God's Son?*

John 19:7 The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law he ought to die, because he made himself the **Son of God.**

- **Question:** *Was the organized church on earth able by their own devising to accept Jesus as the Son of God?*

John 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the **Son of God**; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

- **Question:** *Does this verse state clearly why John wrote his gospel? If we reject what his purpose was in writing this gospel, can we expect to have life?*

Acts 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *What was Philip, an apostle of Christ, asking the eunuch to believe with all his heart?*

Acts 9:20 And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the **Son of God**.

- **Question:** *Why, if this wasn't important and present truth for the Apostle Paul, did he preach this in his ministry?*

Romans 1:4 And declared *to be* the **Son of God** with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

- **Question:** *What with power was Christ declared to be?*

2 Corinthians 1:19 For the **Son of God**, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us, *even* by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea.

- **Question:** *Was there a purpose here in referring to Jesus Christ as the Son of God, whom Paul, Silvanus and Timotheus preached, or was that an unnecessary inclusion of useless words?*

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the **Son of God**, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

- **Question:** *If we are to live by the faith of the Son of God, yet we reject that Christ is really the Son of God, what kind of faith should we expect to have?*

Ephesians 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the **Son of God**, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

- **Question:** *We will need apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers until we all come into the unity of the faith and what else?*

Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the **Son of God**, let us hold fast *our* profession.

- **Question:** *If "Jesus the Son of God" is the high priest, but some believe that Jesus is actually the metaphorical Son of God, then is Jesus also a metaphorical high priest?*

Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the **Son of God** afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.

- **Question:** *If Jesus really isn't the Son of God, then is falling away and renewing ourselves unto repentance really something to concern ourselves with as well? Could some put Him to an open shame by denying what He claimed to be on this earth?*

Hebrews 7:3 Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the **Son of God**; abideth a priest continually.

- **Question:** *Jesus was without record of an earthly father, without record of a heavenly mother, without legal records of his actual birth, and no expectations of his death, so was this how, in type, Melchisedec was like unto Jesus, the Son of God? (There's no genealogical record of the father, mother, birth or death of Melchisedec.)*

Hebrews 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the **Son of God**, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

- **Question:** *If Jesus really wasn't the Son of God, then was the blood He shed really more important than yours or mine?*

1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the **Son of God** was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

- **Question:** *If the Son of God is metaphorical, should we expect a metaphorical destruction of the devil's works in our lives?*

1 John 4:15 Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the **Son of God**, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.

- **Question:** *What is the opposite to this equation? If someone doesn't confess that Jesus is the Son of God, who dwells in him?*

1 John 5:5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the **Son of God**?

- **Question:** *What is someone doesn't believe that Jesus is the Son of God? Would that person overcome the world?*

1 John 5:10 He that believeth on the **Son of God** hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.

- **Question:** *What witness should we have in ourselves? If we don't believe that Jesus is the Son of God in reality, are we really saying that God is a liar, something the Bible says that God cannot do? (See Titus 1:2.)*

1 John 5:12 He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

1 John 5:13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

- **Question:** *Did John really believe that this subject was that serious?*

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

- **Question:** *What does the phrase “that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his son Jesus Christ” tell us of whom the subject of this verse is? If that is referring to the Father—which it is—then the phrase “true God” is referring to the Father. (See John 17:3.)*

Revelation 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass;

- **Question:** *If some do not accept that Jesus is the Son of God, should they be expected to believe what He sent as messages to the churches?*

“I feel my spirit stirred within me. I feel to the depth of my being that the truth must be borne to other countries and nations, and to all classes. Let the missionaries of the cross proclaim that there is one God, and one Mediator between God and man, who is Jesus Christ the Son of the Infinite God. This needs to be proclaimed throughout every church in our land. Christians need to know this, and not put man where God should be, that they may no longer be worshipers of idols, but of the living God. Idolatry exists in our churches. [Means had] better be employed to save souls from death, which would be placing jewels in the crown of Jesus Christ and stars in our own crowns in the kingdom of heaven.” 1888 886.3
