Sinners

Old Testament

Genesis 13:13 But the <u>men</u> of Sodom were wicked and <u>sinners</u> before the LORD exceedingly.

Genesis 20:6 And God said unto him [**Pharaoh**] in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from **sinning** against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her

Exodus 9:27 And **Pharaoh** sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have **sinned** this time: the LORD *is* righteous, and I and my people *are* wicked.

Exodus 9:34 And when **Pharaoh** saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he **sinned** yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.

Exodus 10:16 Then **Pharaoh** called for Moses and Aaron in haste; and he said, I have **sinned** against the LORD your God, and against you.

Exodus 32:30 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said unto the **people**, Ye have **sinned** a great sin: and now I will go up unto the LORD; peradventure I shall make an atonement for your sin. **Exodus 32:31** And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, Oh, this **people** have **sinned** a great sin, and have made them gods of gold.

Exodus 32:33 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Whosoever** hath **sinned** against me, him will I blot out of my book.

Leviticus 4:3 If the **priest** that is anointed do sin according to the sin of the people; then let him bring for his sin, which he hath **sinned**, a young bullock without blemish unto the LORD for a sin offering.

Leviticus 4:14 When the sin, which they have <u>sinned</u> against it, is known, then the <u>congregation</u> shall offer a young bullock for the sin, and bring him before the tabernacle of the congregation.

Leviticus 4:22 When a <u>ruler</u> hath <u>sinned</u>, and done *somewhat* through ignorance *against* any of the commandments of the LORD his God *concerning things* which should not be done, and is guilty; **Leviticus 4:23** Or if <u>his</u> sin, wherein he hath <u>sinned</u>, come to his knowledge; he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a male without blemish:

Leviticus 4:28 Or if his sin, which he **[one of the common people]** hath **sinned**, come to his knowledge: then he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he hath **sinned**.

Leviticus 5:5 And it shall be, when he **[a man]** shall be guilty in one of these *things*, that he shall confess that he hath **sinned** in that *thing*: **Leviticus 5:6** And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD for his sin which he hath **sinned**, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin.

Leviticus 5:10 And he [not able to bring a lamb] shall offer the second *for* a burnt offering, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an atonement for him for his sin which he hath <u>sinned</u>, and it shall be forgiven him. Leviticus 5:11 But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that <u>sinned</u> shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put *any* frankincense thereon: for it *is* a sin offering... Leviticus 5:13 And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he hath <u>sinned</u> in one of these, and it shall be forgiven <u>him</u>: and *the remnant* shall be the priest's, as a meat offering.

Leviticus 6:3 Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely; in any of all these that a **man** doeth, **sinning** therein: **Leviticus 6:4** Then it shall be, because he hath **sinned**, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

Numbers 6:11 And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, and make an atonement for <u>him</u>, for that he <u>sinned</u> by the dead, and shall hallow his head that same day.

Numbers 12:11 And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we **[Aaron and Miriam]** have done foolishly, and wherein we have **sinned**.

Numbers 14:40 And they rose up early in the morning, **[the men that went to search the land]** and gat them up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we *be here*, and will go up unto the place which the LORD hath promised: for we have **sinned**.

Numbers 15:28 And the priest shall make an atonement for the <u>soul</u> that <u>sinneth ignorantly</u>, when he <u>sinneth</u> by <u>ignorance</u> before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him. Numbers 15:29 Ye shall have one law for him that <u>sinneth</u> through <u>ignorance</u>, both for <u>him that is born among the children of Israel</u>, and for <u>the stranger</u> that sojourneth among them.

Numbers 16:38 The censers of these <u>sinners</u> against their own souls <u>[Korah, Dathan, and Abiram]</u>, let them make them broad plates *for* a covering of the altar: for they offered them

before the LORD, therefore they are hallowed: and they shall be a sign unto the children of Israel.

Numbers 21:7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have **sinned**, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. **[Israel]** And Moses prayed for the people.

Numbers 22:34 And <u>Balaam</u> said unto the angel of the LORD, I have <u>sinned</u>; for I knew not that thou stoodest in the way against me: now therefore, if it displease thee, I will get me back again.

Numbers 32:23 But if ye will not do so, behold, ye have <u>sinned</u> against the LORD: and be sure your sin will find you out. <u>Ithe children of Gad and the children of Reuben</u>]

Deuteronomy 1:41 Then ye **[Israel]** answered and said unto me, We have **sinned** against the LORD, we will go up and fight, according to all that the LORD our God commanded us. And when ye had girded on every man his weapons of war, ye were ready to go up into the hill.

Deuteronomy 9:16 And I looked, and, behold, ye **[Israel]** had **sinned** against the LORD your God, *and* had made you a molten calf: ye had turned aside quickly out of the way which the LORD had commanded you.

Deuteronomy 9:18 And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which ye **[Israel] sinned**, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

Deuteronomy 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against <u>a man</u> for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he <u>sinneth</u>: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

Joshua 7:11 <u>Israel</u> hath <u>sinned</u>, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put *it* even among their own stuff.

Joshua 7:20 And **Achan** answered Joshua, and said, Indeed I have **sinned** against the LORD God of Israel, and thus and thus have I done:

Judges 10:10 And the **children of Israel** cried unto the LORD, saying, We have **sinned** against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

Judges 10:15 And the **children of Israel** said unto the LORD, We have **sinned**: do thou unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto thee; deliver us only, we pray thee, this day.

Judges 11:27 Wherefore I [**Jephthah**] have not **sinned** against thee, but thou doest me wrong to war against me: the LORD the Judge be judge this day between the children of Israel and the children of Ammon.

1Samuel 7:6 And they gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured *it* out before the LORD, and fasted on that day, and said there, We **[all Israel]** have **sinned** against the LORD. And Samuel judged the children of Israel in Mizpeh.

1Samuel 12:10 And they cried unto the LORD, and said, We **Israell** have **sinned**, because we have forsaken the LORD, and have served Baalim and Ashtaroth: but now deliver us out of the hand of our enemies, and we will serve thee.

1Samuel 15:18 And the LORD sent thee **[Saul]** on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the **sinners** the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed.

1Samuel 15:24 And **Saul** said unto Samuel, I have **sinned**: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

1Samuel 15:30 Then he **Saull** said, I have **sinned**: *yet* honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God.

1Samuel 19:4 And Jonathan spake good of David unto Saul his father, and said unto him, Let not the king sin against his servant, against **David**; because he hath not **sinned** against thee, and because his works *have been* to thee-ward very good:

1Samuel 24:11 Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt of thy robe, and killed thee not, know thou and see that *there is* neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I **[David]** have not **sinned** against thee; yet thou huntest my soul to take it.

1Samuel 26:21 Then said <u>Saul</u>, I have <u>sinned</u>: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.

2Samuel 12:13 And **David** said unto Nathan, I have **sinned** against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

2Samuel 19:20 For thy servant doth know that I **[Shimei]** have **sinned**: therefore, behold, I am come the first this day of all the house of Joseph to go down to meet my lord the king.

- **2Samuel 24:10** And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And **David** said unto the LORD, I have **sinned** greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.
- **2Samuel 24:17** And **David** spake unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the people, and said, Lo, I have **sinned**, and I have done wickedly: but these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's house.
- **1Kings 8:33** When thy people **Israel** be smitten down before the enemy, because they have **sinned** against thee, and shall turn again to thee, and confess thy name, and pray, and make supplication unto thee in this house:
- **1Kings 8:35** When heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they **[Israel]** have **sinned** against thee; if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou afflictest them:
- **1Kings 8:46** If they **[Israel]** sin against thee, (for *there is* no man that <u>sinneth</u> not,) and thou be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near;
- **1Kings 8:47** *Yet* if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We **[Israel]** have **sinned**, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness;
- **1Kings 8:50** And forgive **thy people** that have **sinned** against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them:
- **1Kings 15:30** Because of the sins of **Jeroboam** which he **sinned**, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.
- **1Kings 16:13** For all the sins of **Baasha**, and the sins of **Elah his son**, by which they **sinned**, and by which they made Israel to sin, in provoking the LORD God of Israel to anger with their vanities
- **1Kings 16:19** For his sins which he **[Zimri]** sinned in doing evil in the sight of the LORD, in walking in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin which he did, to make Israel to sin.
- **1Kings 18:9** And he said, What have I **[Obadiah]** sinned, that thou wouldest deliver thy servant into the hand of Ahab, to slay me?

2Kings 17:7 For *so* it was, that the **children of Israel** had **sinned** against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

2Kings 21:17 Now the rest of the acts of **Manasseh**, and all that he did, and his sin that he **sinned**, *are* they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

1Chronicles 21:8 And **David** said unto God, I have **sinned** greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

1Chronicles 21:17 And **David** said unto God, *Is it* not I *that* commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have **sinned** and done evil indeed; but *as for* these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.

2Chronicles 6:24 And if **thy people** Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have **sinned** against thee; and shall return and confess thy name, and pray and make supplication before thee in this house;

2Chronicles 6:26 When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they **[Israel]** have **sinned** against thee; *yet* if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them;

2Chronicles 6:36 If they **[Israel]** sin against thee, (for *there is* no man which <u>sinneth</u> not,) and thou be angry with them, and deliver them over before *their* enemies, and they carry them away captives unto a land far off or near;

2Chronicles 6:37 Yet *if* they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto thee in the land of their captivity, saying, We **[Israel]** have **sinned**, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly;

2Chronicles 6:39 Then hear thou from the heavens, *even* from thy dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive **thy people** which have **sinned** against thee.

Nehemiah 1:6 Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the **children of Israel**, which we have **sinned** against thee: both I and my father's house have **sinned**.

Nehemiah 9:29 And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they [Israel] dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against

thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

Job 1:5 And it was so, when the days of *their* feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, and offered burnt offerings *according* to the number of them all: for Job said, It may be that **my sons** have **sinned**, and cursed God in their hearts. Thus did Job continually.

Job 1:22 In all this <u>Job sinned</u> not, nor charged God foolishly.

Job 7:20 I **[Job]** have **sinned**; what shall I do unto thee, O thou preserver of men? why hast thou set me as a mark against thee, so that I am a burden to myself?

Job 8:4 If **thy children** have **sinned** against him, and he have cast them away for their transgression;

Job 24:19 Drought and heat consume the snow waters: *so doth* the grave *those* [murderer, thief, adulterer] *which* have sinned.

Job 33:27 He looketh upon men, and *if* **any** say, I have **sinned**, and perverted *that which was* right, and it profited me not;

Job 35:6 If thou **[Job]** sinnest, what doest thou against him? or *if* thy transgressions be multiplied, what doest thou unto him?

Psalms 1:1 Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the <u>ungodly</u>, nor standeth in the way of <u>sinners</u>, nor sitteth in the seat of the <u>scornful</u>.

Psalms 1:5 Therefore the <u>ungodly</u> shall not stand in the judgment, nor <u>sinners</u> in the congregation of the righteous.

Psalms 25:8 Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.

Psalms 26:9 Gather not my soul [**David**] with sinners, nor my life with bloody men:

Psalms 41:4 I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I **[David]** have **sinned** against thee.

Psalms 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I **[David]** sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

Psalms 51:13 *Then* will I teach transgressors thy ways; and **sinners** shall be converted unto thee.

Psalms 78:17 And they **[Israel]** sinned yet more against him by provoking the most High in the wilderness.

Psalms 78:32 For all this they **[Israel]** sinned still, and believed not for his wondrous works.

Psalms 104:35 Let the <u>sinners</u> be consumed out of the earth, and let the <u>wicked</u> be no more. Bless thou the LORD, O my soul. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalms 106:6 We **Israel** have **sinned** with our fathers, we have committed iniquity, we have done wickedly.

Proverbs 1:10 My son, if **sinners** entice thee, consent thou not.

Proverbs 8:36 But he that **sinneth** against me wrongeth his own soul: all **they that hate me** love death

Proverbs 11:31 Behold, the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the **wicked** and the **sinner**.

Proverbs 13:6 Righteousness keepeth *him that is* upright in the way: but wickedness overthroweth the **sinner**.

Proverbs 13:21 Evil pursueth <u>sinners</u>: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.

Proverbs 13:22 A good *man* leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the **sinner** *is* laid up for the just.

Proverbs 14:21 He that **despiseth his neighbour sinneth**: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy *is* he.

Proverbs 19:2 Also, *that* the soul *be* without knowledge, *it is* not good; and **he that hasteth** with his feet sinneth.

Proverbs 20:2 The fear of a king *is* as the roaring of a lion: *whoso* **provoketh him to anger sinneth** *against* his own soul.

Proverbs 23:17 Let not thine heart envy <u>sinners</u>: but *be thou* in the fear of the LORD all the day long.

Ecclesiastes 2:26 For *God* giveth to a man that *is* good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the <u>sinner</u> he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to *him that is* good before God. This also *is* vanity and vexation of spirit.

Ecclesiastes 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

Ecclesiastes 7:26 And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart *is* snares and nets, *and* her hands *as* bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the <u>sinner</u> shall be taken by her.

Ecclesiastes 8:12 Though a <u>sinner do evil</u> an hundred times, and his *days* be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him:

Ecclesiastes 9:2 All *things come* alike to all: *there is* one event to the righteous, and to the wicked; to the good and to the clean, and to the unclean; to him that sacrificeth, and to him that sacrificeth not: as *is* the good, so *is* the sinner; and he that sweareth, as he that feareth an oath.

Ecclesiastes 9:18 Wisdom *is* better than weapons of war: but one sinner destroyeth much good.

Isaiah 1:28 And the destruction of the <u>transgressors</u> and of the <u>sinners</u> *shall be* together, and they that <u>forsake the LORD</u> shall be consumed.

Isaiah 13:9 Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the **sinners** thereof out of it.

Isaiah 33:14 The <u>sinners</u> in Zion are <u>afraid</u>; <u>fearfulness</u> hath <u>surprised</u> the <u>hypocrites</u>. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

Isaiah 42:24 Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the LORD, he against whom we **[Israel]** have **sinned**? for they **would not walk in his ways**, neither were they **obedient unto his law**.

Isaiah 43:27 Thy <u>first father</u> hath <u>sinned</u>, and thy <u>teachers</u> have <u>transgressed</u> against me.

Isaiah 64:5 Thou meetest him that rejoiceth and worketh righteousness, *those that* remember thee in thy ways: behold, thou art wroth; for we **[Israel]** have **sinned**: in those is continuance, and we shall be saved.

Isaiah 65:20 There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the **sinner** *being* an hundred years old shall be **accursed**.

Jeremiah 2:35 Yet thou sayest, Because I am **innocent**, surely his anger shall turn from me. Behold, I will plead with thee, because thou sayest, I have **not sinned**.

Jeremiah 3:25 We lie down in our shame, and our confusion covereth us: for we have **sinned** against the LORD our God, **we and our fathers**, from our **youth** even unto this day, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD our God.

Jeremiah 8:14 Why do we sit still? assemble yourselves, and let us enter into the defenced cities, and let us be silent there: for the LORD our God hath put us to silence, and given us water of gall to drink, because we **Israel** have **sinned** against the LORD.

Jeremiah 14:7 O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, do thou *it* for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we **[Israel]** have **sinned** against thee.

Jeremiah 14:20 We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, *and* the iniquity of our fathers: for we **[Israel]** have **sinned** against thee.

Jeremiah 33:8 And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have <u>sinned</u> against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they <u>[Israel]</u> have <u>sinned</u>, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

Jeremiah 40:3 Now the LORD hath brought *it*, and done according as he hath said: because ye **Jeremiah/Israel** have **sinned** against the LORD, and have not obeyed his voice, therefore this thing is come upon you.

Jeremiah 44:23 Because ye have burned incense, and because ye **[Judah]** have **sinned** against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day.

Jeremiah 50:7 All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they **[Israel]** have **sinned** against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.

Jeremiah 50:14 Put yourselves in array against **Babylon** round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath **sinned** against the LORD.

Lamentations 1:8 <u>Jerusalem</u> hath grievously <u>sinned</u>; therefore she is removed: all that honoured her despise her, because they have seen her nakedness: yea, she sigheth, and turneth backward.

Lamentations 5:7 Our <u>fathers</u> have <u>sinned</u>, and are not; and we have borne their iniquities.

Lamentations 5:16 The crown is fallen *from* our head: woe unto us, that we **[Israel]** have **sinned**!

Ezekiel 14:13 Son of man, when the land **[house of Israel]** sinneth against me by trespassing grievously, then will I stretch out mine hand upon it, and will break the staff of the bread thereof, and will send famine upon it, and will cut off man and beast from it:

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the **soul** that **sinneth**, it shall die.

Ezekiel 18:20 The <u>soul</u> that <u>sinneth</u>, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.

Ezekiel 18:24 But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, *and* doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked *man* doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in **his** sin that he hath **sinned**, in them shall he die.

Ezekiel 28:16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast <u>sinned</u>: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O <u>covering cherub</u>, from the midst of the stones of fire.

Ezekiel 33:12 Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the **righteous** be able to live for his *righteousness* in the day that he **sinneth**.

Ezekiel 37:23 Neither shall they <u>defile</u> themselves any more with their <u>idols</u>, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their <u>transgressions</u>: but I will save them out of all their dwellingplaces, wherein they have <u>sinned</u>, and will <u>cleanse</u> them: so shall they be <u>my people</u>, and I will be <u>their God</u>.

Daniel 9:5 <u>We</u> have <u>sinned</u>, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments:

Daniel 9:8 O Lord, to us *belongeth* confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because **we** have **sinned** against thee.

Daniel 9:11 Yea, <u>all Israel</u> have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that *is* written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because <u>we</u> have <u>sinned</u> against him.

Daniel 9:15 And now, O Lord our God, that hast brought thy people forth out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand, and hast gotten thee renown, as at this day; **we** have **sinned**, we have done wickedly.

Hosea 4:7 As they were increased, so they **[Israel]** sinned against me: therefore will I change their glory into shame.

Hosea 10:9 O **Israel**, thou hast **sinned** from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of iniquity did not overtake them.

Amos 9:10 All the **sinners** of **my people** shall die by the sword, which say, The evil shall not overtake nor prevent us.

Micah 7:9 I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because **I** have **sinned** against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, *and* I shall behold his righteousness.

Habakkuk 2:10 Thou [Babylon] hast consulted shame to thy house by cutting off many people, and hast sinned against thy soul.

Zephaniah 1:17 And I will bring distress upon **men**, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have **sinned** against the LORD: and their blood shall be poured out as dust, and their flesh as the dung.

New Testament

Matthew 9:10 And it came to pass, as Jesus sat at meat in the house, behold, many publicans and **sinners** [**Matthew and others**] came and sat down with him and his disciples. **Matthew 9:11** And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and **sinners**? [**Matthew and others**]

Matthew 9:13 But go ye and learn what *that* meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but **sinners** [general populace, including Matthew and others] to repentance.

Matthew 11:19 The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and <u>sinners</u>. <u>[possibly a reference to the likes of Matthew and others]</u> But wisdom is justified of her children.

Matthew 26:45 Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take *your* rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of <u>sinners</u>.

[Judas and the Roman soldiers with the priests]

Matthew 27:4 Saying, I **Judas Iscariot**] have **sinned** in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What *is that* to us? see thou *to that*.

Mark 2:15 And it came to pass, that, as Jesus sat at meat in his house, many publicans and sinners [Matthew and others] sat also together with Jesus and his disciples: for there were many, and they followed him. Mark 2:16 And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, [Matthew and others] they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners? [Matthew and others] Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard it, he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners [general populace, including Matthew and others] to repentance.

Mark 14:41 And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take *your* rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of <u>sinners</u>.

[Judas and the Roman soldiers with the priests]

Luke 5:30 But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners? [Matthew and others]

Luke 5:32 I came not to call the righteous, but <u>sinners</u> [general populace, including Matthew and others] to repentance.

Luke 6:32 For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners [non-followers of God and of Christ] also love those that love them.

Luke 6:33 And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners [non-followers of God and of Christ] also do even the same.

Luke 6:34 And if ye lend to them of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, [non-followers of God and of Christ] to receive as much again.

Luke 7:34 The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners! [possibly a reference to the likes of Matthew and others]

Luke 7:37 And, behold, a <u>woman</u> in the city, which was a <u>sinner</u>, when she knew that *Jesus* sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

Luke 7:39 Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw *it*, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman *this is* that toucheth him: for **she** is a **sinner**.

Luke 13:2 And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these <u>Galilaeans</u> were <u>sinners</u> above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things?

Luke 13:4 Or those **eighteen**, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were **sinners** above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

Luke 15:1 Then drew near unto him all the publicans and <u>sinners</u> [general populace] for to hear him. Luke 15:2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth <u>sinners</u>, [general populace] and eateth with them.

Luke 15:7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one <u>sinner</u> that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine <u>iust persons</u>, which <u>need no repentance</u>.

Luke 15:10 Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one **sinner** that **repenteth**.

Luke 15:18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, **I** have **sinned** against heaven, and before thee,

Luke 15:21 And the **son** said unto him, Father, **I** have **sinned** against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.

Luke 18:13 And the **publican**, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as *his* eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a **sinner**.

Luke 19:7 And when they saw *it*, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a **sinner**. **[Zacchaeus]**

John 9:3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this **man [blind from his birth] sinned**, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.

John 9:16 Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man **[Jesus]** that is a **sinner** do such miracles? And there was a division among them.

John 9:24 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man **[Jesus]** is a **sinner**. **John 9:25** He answered and said, Whether he **[Jesus]** be a **sinner** *or no*, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

John 9:31 Now we know that God heareth not <u>sinners</u>: but if any man be <u>a worshipper of God</u>, and doeth his will, him he heareth. [See Psalms 66:18]

Romans 2:12 For as many as have <u>sinned</u> <u>without law</u> shall also perish without law: and as many as have <u>sinned</u> in the law shall be judged by the law;

Romans 3:7 For if the truth of God hath more abounded through my lie unto his glory; why yet am **I** also judged as a **sinner**?

Romans 3:23 For <u>all have sinned</u>, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that <u>all have sinned</u>:

Romans 5:14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over <u>them that had not</u> <u>sinned</u> after the similitude of <u>Adam's transgression</u>, who is the figure of him that was to come.

Romans 5:16 And not as *it was* by **one** that **sinned**, *so is* the gift: for the judgment *was* by one to condemnation, but the free gift *is* of many offences unto justification.

Romans 5:19 For as by one man's disobedience <u>many</u> were made <u>sinners</u>, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

1Corinthians 6:18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but **he that committeth fornication sinneth** against his own body.

1Corinthians 7:28 But and if **thou** marry, thou hast not **sinned**; and if a **virgin** marry, she hath not **sinned**. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.

1Corinthians 7:36 But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of *her* age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.

2Corinthians 12:21 *And* lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and *that* I shall bewail <u>many which have sinned</u> already, and have <u>not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness</u> which they have committed.

2Corinthians 13:2 I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which **heretofore have sinned**, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare:

Galatians 2:15 We who are Jews by nature, and not sinners of the Gentiles,

Galatians 2:17 But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.

1Timothy 1:9 Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the <u>lawless</u> and <u>disobedient</u>, for the <u>ungodly</u> and for <u>sinners</u>, for <u>unholy</u> and <u>profane</u>, for <u>murderers</u> of fathers and <u>murderers</u> of mothers, for <u>manslayers</u>,

1Timothy 1:15 This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that **Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners**; of whom I am chief.

Titus 3:11 Knowing that he that is such is **subverted [perverted, in the Greek]**, and **sinneth**, being **condemned** of himself.

Hebrews 3:17 But with whom was he grieved forty years? *was it* not with them that had <u>sinned</u>, <u>[Israel]</u> whose carcases fell in the wilderness?

Hebrews 7:26 For such an high priest became us, *who is* **holy**, **harmless**, **undefiled**, **separate** from **sinners**, and made higher than the heavens;

Hebrews 12:3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of **sinners [general populace]** against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

James 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. <u>Cleanse your hands</u>, ye <u>sinners</u>; and purify your hearts, ye <u>double minded</u>.

James 5:20 Let him know, that he which converteth the <u>sinner</u> from the <u>error of his way</u> shall save a soul from <u>death</u>, and shall hide a multitude of <u>sins</u>.

1Peter 4:18 And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the **ungodly** and the **sinner** appear?

2Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the <u>angels that sinned</u>, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of <u>darkness</u>, to be reserved unto <u>judgment</u>;

1John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

1John 3:6 Whosoever <u>abideth in him sinneth</u> not: whosoever <u>sinneth</u> hath <u>not seen him</u>, neither **known him**.

1John 3:8 He that **committeth sin** is **of the devil**; for the **devil sinneth** from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the **works** of the devil.

1John 5:18 We know that whosoever is **born of God sinneth not**; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that **wicked one toucheth him not**.

Jude 15 To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are <u>ungodly</u> among them of all their u<u>ngodly deeds</u> which they have <u>ungodly committed</u>, and of all their hard *speeches* which <u>ungodly sinners</u> have spoken against him.
