Spirit and Mind Bible Texts

Genesis 41:7-8, <u>Pharaoh</u> awoke, and, behold, it was a dream. And it came to pass in the morning that his **spirit** was **troubled**;

Exodus 6:9 And Moses spake so unto the <u>children of Israel</u>: but they hearkened not unto Moses for **anguish of spirit**, and for cruel bondage.

Exodus 28:3 And thou shalt speak unto <u>all that are wise hearted</u>, whom I have filled with the **spirit of wisdom**, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 31:3 And I have filled <u>him</u> with the **spirit of God**, in **wisdom**, and in **understanding**, and in **knowledge**, and in all manner of workmanship,

Exodus 35:21 And <u>they came</u>, every one whose **heart stirred him up**, and <u>every one</u> whom his **spirit made willing**, and they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.

Numbers 5:14 And the **spirit** of **jealousy** come upon <u>him</u>, and <u>he</u> be **jealous** of <u>his</u> wife, and she be defiled: or if the spirit of jealousy come upon <u>him</u>, and <u>he</u> be jealous of <u>his</u> wife, and she be not defiled:

Deuteronomy 2:30 But <u>Sihon king of Heshbon</u> would not let us pass by <u>him</u>: for the LORD thy God **hardened** <u>his</u> **spirit**, and made his **heart obstinate**, that he might deliver <u>him</u> into thy hand, as appeareth this day.

Deuteronomy 34:9 And <u>Joshua the son of Nun</u> was full of the **spirit of wisdom**; for Moses had laid his hands upon <u>him</u>: and the children of Israel hearkened unto <u>him</u>, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.

1 Samuel 1:15 And <u>Hannah</u> answered and said, No, my lord, <u>I</u> am a <u>woman</u> of a **sorrowful spirit**: <u>I</u> have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out <u>my</u> soul before the LORD.

1 Samuel 16:14 But the **Spirit** of the LORD **departed** from <u>Saul</u>, and an **evil spirit** from the LORD **troubled** <u>him</u>.

[In this context, it seems that the peace of mind from God was no longer with him, but rather a troubled conscience. Consider the various ways this word "evil" has been translated by looking to a concordance: H7451 "adversity, affliction, bad, calamity, + displease(-ure), distress, evil((-favouredness), man, thing), + exceedingly, x great, grief(-vous), harm, heavy, hurt(-ful), ill

(favoured), + mark, mischief(-vous), misery, naught(-ty), noisome, + not please, sad(-ly), sore, sorrow, trouble, vex, wicked(-ly, -ness, one), worse(-st), wretchedness, wrong."]

1 Chronicles 5:26 And the God of Israel **stirred up the spirit** of <u>Pul king of Assyria</u>, and the **spirit** of <u>Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria</u>, and he carried <u>them</u> away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought <u>them</u> unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.

2Chr. 36:22 Now in the first year of <u>Cyrus king of Persia</u>, that the word of the LORD spoken by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD **stirred up the spirit** of <u>Cyrus king of Persia</u>, that he made a proclamation throughout all <u>his</u> kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying,

Job 21:4 As for me, is my complaint to man? and if it were so, why should not my spirit be troubled?

Psalms 32:2 Blessed is <u>the man</u> unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose **spirit** there is **no guile**.

Psalms 51:12 Restore unto <u>me</u> the **joy** of thy salvation; and uphold <u>me</u> with thy **free spirit**.

Psalms 77:3 <u>I</u> remembered God, and was troubled: <u>I</u> complained, and <u>my</u> spirit was overwhelmed.

Psalms 106:33 Because they **provoked** his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips.

Psalms 142:3 When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me.

Psalms 143:4 Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate.

Proverbs 18:14 The **spirit** of a <u>man</u> will **sustain** his infirmity; but a **wounded spirit** who can bear?

Ecclesiastes 1:17 And <u>I</u> gave <u>my</u> **heart** to **know** wisdom, and to know madness and folly: <u>I</u> perceived that this also is **vexation** of **spirit**.

Ecclesiastes 2:11 Then \underline{I} looked on all the works that \underline{my} hands had wrought, and on the labour that \underline{I} had laboured to do: and, behold, all was vanity and **vexation** of **spirit**, and there was no profit under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 2:17 Therefore <u>I</u> hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun is **grievous** unto <u>me</u>: for all is vanity and **vexation** of **spirit**.

Ecclesiastes 4:4 Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this a <u>man</u> is envied of his <u>neighbour</u>. This is also vanity and **vexation** of **spirit**.

Isaiah 29:24 <u>They</u> also that **erred** in **spirit** shall come to **understanding**, and <u>they</u> that murmured shall **learn** doctrine.

Isaiah 54:6 For the LORD hath called thee as a <u>woman</u> **forsaken** and **grieved** in **spirit**, and a wife of youth, when <u>thou</u> wast refused, saith thy God.

Isaiah 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of **joy** for **mourning**, the garment of **praise** for the **spirit** of **heaviness**; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

Isaiah 63:10 But <u>they</u> **rebelled**, and **vexed his** holy **Spirit**: therefore he was turned to be <u>their</u> enemy, and he fought against <u>them</u>.

Isaiah 65:14 Behold, my <u>servants</u> shall **sing** for **joy** of **heart**, but <u>ye</u> shall **cry** for **sorrow** of **heart**, and shall **howl** for **vexation** of **spirit**.

Ezekiel 18:31 Cast away from <u>you</u> all <u>your</u> transgressions, whereby <u>ye</u> have transgressed; and make <u>you</u> a **new heart** and a **new spirit**: for why will <u>ye</u> die, O <u>house of Israel</u>?

Ezek. 36:26 A **new heart** also will I give <u>you</u>, and a **new spirit** will I put within <u>you</u>: and I will take away the **stony heart** out of <u>your</u> flesh, and I will give <u>you</u> an **heart of flesh**.

Daniel 2:1 In the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> dreamed dreams, wherewith his **spirit** was **troubled**, and his sleep brake from him.

Daniel 2:3 And the <u>king</u> said unto them, <u>I</u> have dreamed a dream, and <u>my</u> **spirit** was **troubled** to know the dream.

Daniel 7:15 I <u>Daniel</u> was **grieved** in <u>my</u> **spirit** in the midst of <u>my</u> body, and the visions of <u>my</u> head **troubled** me.

Hosea 4:12 My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: for the **spirit** of **whoredoms** hath caused <u>them</u> to err, and <u>they</u> have gone a whoring from under <u>their</u> God.

Haggai 1:14 And the LORD **stirred up the spirit** of <u>Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel</u>, governor of Judah, and the **spirit** of <u>Joshua the son of Josedech</u>, the high priest, and the **spirit** of all the <u>remnant of the people</u>; and <u>they</u> came and **did work** in the house of the LORD of hosts, <u>their</u> God, ["They had **a mind to work**..." Nehemiah 4:6]

Zechariah 12:10 And I will pour upon the <u>house of David</u>, and upon the <u>inhabitants of Jerusalem</u>, the **spirit of grace and of supplications**: and <u>they</u> shall look upon me whom <u>they</u> have pierced, and <u>they</u> shall **mourn** for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in **bitterness** for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

Malachi 2:15 And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That <u>he might seek a godly seed</u>. Therefore **take heed to your spirit**, and let none deal **treacherously** against the wife of his youth.

Malachi 2:16 For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore **take heed to your spirit**, that ye deal not treacherously.

Matt. 3:16 And <u>Jesus</u>, when <u>he</u> was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto <u>him</u>, and <u>he</u> saw the **Spirit** of God **descending** like a dove, and lighting upon <u>him</u>: [How did the 'mind' of God come down as a dove? Through the Words God spoke in the next verse. See John 6:63.]

Matthew 5:3 Blessed are the **poor** in **spirit**: for <u>theirs</u> is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, that <u>ye</u> enter not into temptation: the **spirit** indeed is **willing**, but the flesh is weak.

Mark 2:8 And immediately when <u>Jesus</u> perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason <u>ye</u> these things in <u>your</u> hearts?

Mark 8:12 And <u>he</u> **sighed deeply in his spirit**, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation.

Mark 9:17 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee <u>my son</u>, which hath a **dumb spirit**;

Luke 1:47 And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

Luke 1:80 And the <u>child</u> grew, and **waxed strong in spirit**, and was in the deserts till the day of <u>his</u> shewing unto Israel.

Luke 2:40 And the <u>child</u> grew, and **waxed strong in spirit**, filled with **wisdom**: and the grace of God was upon <u>him</u>.

Luke 4:18 The **Spirit** of the Lord is upon <u>me</u>, because he hath **anointed** <u>me</u> **to preach** the gospel to the poor; he hath sent <u>me</u> to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Luke 9:55 But he turned, and rebuked <u>them</u>, and said, <u>Ye</u> know not what **manner of spirit** <u>ye</u> are of.

Luke 10:21 In that hour <u>Jesus</u> **rejoiced** in **spirit**, and said, <u>I</u> thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

John 11:33 When <u>Jesus</u> therefore saw her weeping, and the Jesus also weeping which came with her, <u>he</u> groaned in the spirit, and was troubled,

John 13:21 When <u>Jesus</u> had thus said, he was **troubled** in **spirit**, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, <u>I</u> say unto you, that one of you shall betray <u>me</u>.

Acts 2:4 And they were all **filled** with the **Holy Ghost**, and began to **speak** with other tongues, as the **Spirit** gave them utterance.

Acts 11:12 And the **Spirit** bade me go with them, **nothing doubting**. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house:

Acts 16:7 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the **Spirit** suffered them **not**.

Acts 17:16 Now while <u>Paul</u> waited for them at Athens, <u>his</u> **spirit was stirred** in <u>him</u>, when <u>he</u> saw the city wholly given to idolatry.

Acts 18:5 And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, <u>Paul</u> was **pressed in the spirit**, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ.

Acts 18:25 <u>This man</u> was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being **fervent in the spirit**, <u>he</u> spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John.

Acts 19:21 After these things were ended, <u>Paul</u> **purposed in the spirit**, when <u>he</u> had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, **to go** to Jerusalem, saying, After <u>I</u> have been there, <u>I</u> must also see Rome.

Romans 1:4 And declared to be the <u>Son of God</u> with power, according to the **spirit of holiness**, by the resurrection from the dead:

Romans 7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in **newness of spirit**, and not in the oldness of the letter.

Romans 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in <u>us</u>, who **walk** not after the flesh, but **after the Spirit**.

Romans 8:11 But if the **Spirit** of <u>him that raised up Jesus</u> from the dead **dwell in** you, <u>he that raised up Christ</u> from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by <u>his</u> **Spirit that dwelleth** in you.

Romans 8:14 For <u>as many</u> as are **led by the Spirit of God**, they are the <u>sons</u> of God. Rom. 8:15 For <u>ye</u> have **not received the spirit of bondage again** to fear; but <u>ye</u> have received the **Spirit of adoption**, whereby <u>we</u> cry, Abba, Father.

Romans 8:26 Likewise the **Spirit** also **helpeth** <u>our</u> **infirmities**: for <u>we</u> know not what <u>we</u> should pray for as <u>we</u> ought: but the **Spirit itself** maketh intercession for <u>us</u> with groanings which cannot be uttered.

- 1 Corinthians. 2:10 But God hath **revealed** them unto <u>us</u> **by his Spirit**: for the **Spirit searcheth** all things, yea, the deep things of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:14 But the <u>natural man</u> receiveth not the things of the **Spirit of God**: for they are **foolishness** unto <u>him</u>: neither can <u>he</u> **know** them, because they are spiritually **discerned**.
- 1 Corinthians 4:21 What will ye? shall <u>I</u> come unto you with a **rod**, or in **love**, and in the **spirit** of **meekness**?
- 1 Corinthians 5:3 For <u>I</u> verily, as **absent in body**, but **present in spirit**, have judged already, **as though** <u>I</u> were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed,
- 1 Corinthians 5:4 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 1 Corinthians 5:5 To deliver <u>such an one</u> unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the **spirit may be saved** in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 6:17 But <u>he</u> that is **joined** unto the Lord is **one spirit**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:40 But she is happier if she so abide, after **my judgment**: and I think also that <u>I</u> have **the Spirit of God**.
- 1 Corinthians 12:3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no <u>man</u> speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no <u>man</u> can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

- 1 Corinthians 16:18 For they have **refreshed my spirit and yours**: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.
- 2 Corinthians 3:3 Forasmuch as <u>ye</u> are manifestly declared to be the **epistle of Christ** ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the **Spirit of the living God**; not in tables of stone, but **in fleshy tables of the heart**.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 4:13 <u>We</u> having the **same spirit of faith**, according as it is written, I **believed**, and **therefore** have I spoken; <u>we</u> also **believe**, and **therefore** speak;
- 2 Corinthians 7:1 Having therefore these **promises**, dearly beloved, let <u>us</u> **cleanse ourselves** from all filthiness of the **flesh and spirit**, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 2 Corinthians 7:13 Therefore <u>we</u> were **comforted** in <u>your</u> **comfort**: yea, and exceedingly the more <u>joyed</u> <u>we</u> for the <u>joy</u> of <u>Titus</u>, because <u>his</u> **spirit** was **refreshed** by <u>you</u> all.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if <u>he that cometh</u> preacheth **another Jesus**, whom <u>we</u> have not preached, or if <u>ye</u> receive **another spirit**, which <u>ye</u> have not received, or **another gospel**, which <u>ye</u> have not accepted, <u>ye</u> might well bear with him.
- 2 Corinthians 12:18 I desired Titus, and with him I sent a brother. Did Titus make a gain of you? walked <u>we</u> not in the **same spirit**? walked <u>we</u> not in the **same steps**?
- Gal. 3:2 This only would I learn of <u>you</u>, **Received** <u>ye</u> the **Spirit** by the works of the law, or by the **hearing** of faith?
- Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the **Spirit** is **love**, **joy**, **peace**, **longsuffering**, **gentleness**, **goodness**, **faith**, **Meekness**, **temperance**: against such there is no law.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, <u>ye which are</u> **spiritual**, restore such an one in the **spirit of meekness**; considering <u>thyself</u>, lest <u>thou</u> also be tempted.
- Ephesians 1:13 In whom <u>ye</u> also **trusted**, after that <u>ye</u> **heard** the word of truth, the gospel of <u>your</u> salvation: in whom also after that <u>ye</u> **believed**, <u>ye</u> were **sealed** with that **holy Spirit of promise**,
- Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past <u>ye</u> walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the <u>children</u> of **disobedience**:

Ephesians 3:5 Which in other ages was **not made known** unto the sons of men, as it is now **revealed** unto his <u>holy apostles</u> and <u>prophets</u> by the **Spirit**;

Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the **unity** of the **Spirit** in the **bond** of **peace**. Ephesians 4:4 There is **one body**, and **one Spirit**, even as <u>ye</u> are called in **one hope** of <u>your</u> calling;

Eph. 4:23 And be **renewed** in the **spirit** of <u>your</u> **mind**;

Ephesians 4:30 **Grieve** not the holy **Spirit** of **God**, whereby <u>ye</u> are **sealed** unto the day of redemption.

Colossians 2:5 For though \underline{I} be **absent** in the **flesh**, yet am \underline{I} with you in the **spirit**, **joying** and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace **sanctify** <u>you</u> **wholly**; and I pray God <u>your</u> whole **spirit** and **soul** and **body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ
- 2 Thessalonians 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the <u>Lord</u> shall consume with the **spirit of his mouth**, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for <u>you</u>, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen <u>you</u> to salvation through **sanctification** of the **Spirit** and **belief** of the **truth**:
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given <u>us</u> the **spirit** of **fear**; but of **power**, and of **love**, and of a **sound mind**.
- 2 Timothy 4:22 The Lord Jesus Christ be with thy spirit. Grace be with you. Amen.
- 1 Peter 1:2 <u>Elect</u> according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through **sanctification of the Spirit**, unto **obedience** and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto <u>you</u>, and peace, be multiplied.
- 1 Peter 1:11 Searching what, or what manner of time the **Spirit of Christ** which was **in** them did signify, when it **testified** beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.
- 1 John 4:1 <u>Beloved</u>, **believe** not every **spirit**, but **try the spirits** whether they are **of God**: because many **false prophets** are gone out into the world.

Revelation 1:10 \underline{I} was **in the Spirit** on the Lord's day, and heard behind \underline{me} a great voice, as of a trumpet,

Revelation 4:2 And immediately \underline{I} was **in the spirit**: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

Revelation 17:3 So he carried <u>me</u> away **in the spirit** into the wilderness: and <u>I</u> saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

Revelation 21:10 And he carried <u>me</u> away **in the spirit** to a great and high mountain, and shewed <u>me</u> that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Notice how Paul understood Isaiah's words regarding God's Spirit:

Isaiah 40:13 **Who** hath **directed** the **Spirit** of the <u>LORD</u>, or being <u>his</u> **counsellor** hath taught him?

Romans 11:34 For **who** hath **known** the **mind** of the Lord? or who hath been his **counsellor**?

Considering Paul's understanding, look at 1 Corinthians 2:11, "For what <u>man</u> knoweth the things of a <u>man</u>, save the **spirit** of <u>man</u> which is **in** <u>him</u>? even so the things of <u>God</u> knoweth no <u>man</u>, but the **Spirit** of <u>God</u>."

Some conclude that because Paul does not include the phrase "which is in Him" for God in this verse, that it has deep significance that God doesn't have the same type of Spirit—as though God's Spirit can be apart from His being. But can something omitted in such a way define for us the fact that God can be separated from His Spirit? Does that verse allow for a functioning spirit without a body?

The Bible concludes that "the body without the spirit is dead" (James 2:26). The opposite is true as well: the spirit without the body is dead. "God is a spirit," according to John 4:24, yet He also has a "shape" or a "form" (John 5:37, Philippians 2:6). So, just as man was made in the "image of God" (Genesis 2:26-27), we can conclude that we are like Him in this regard.

The face of God is mentioned throughout the Bible in various ways and reasons: Genesis 32:30, Exodus 33:11, 20-23, Leviticus 17:10, 20:3, 26:27, Numbers 6:25-26, Deuteronomy 5:4, 31:17-18, 34:10, 1 Chronicles 16:11, 2 Chronicles 7:14, 30:9, Job 34:29, Psalm 4:6, 13:1, 22:24, 24:6, 27:9, 30:7, 31:16, 34:16, 44:24, 51:9, 67:1, 69:17, 80:19, 88:14, 102:2, 104:29, 105:4, 119:135, 143:7, Isaiah 8:17, 54:8, 64:7, Jeremiah 18:17, 33:5, Ezekiel 7:22, 14:8, 15:7, 20:35, 39:23-24, 29, Hosea 5:15, Micah 3:4, Matthew 18:10, 1 Corinthians 13:12, 1 Peter 3:12, Revelation 6:16, and more...

Also, according to the Bible, God has hair (Daniel 7:9), eyes (Genesis 6:8), ears (Numbers 14:28), a nose (Isaiah 65:5), nostrils (2 Samuel 22:7-10), a mouth (Deuteronomy 8:3), lips (Psalm 89:34), arms (Isaiah 53:1), a back (Exodus 33:20-23), hands (Joshua 4:24), legs (Genesis 3:8), and feet (Isaiah 66:1). We are made in God's image as beings with a spirit/mind.
