Matthew (33 / 1,071 verses - 3%)

- **Matthew 3:17** And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- **Matthew 4:3** And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.
- **Matthew 4:6** And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in *their* hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.
- **Matthew 7:21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?
- **Matthew 10:32** Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.
- **Matthew 10:33** But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
- **Matthew 10:40** He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
- Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.
- **Matthew 11:27** All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and *he* to whomsoever the Son will reveal *him*.
- Matthew 14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.
- **Matthew 16:16** And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- **Matthew 16:17** And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
- **Matthew 16:27** For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

- **Matthew 17:5** While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.
- Matthew 20:8 So when even was come, the lord of the vineyard saith unto his steward, Call the labourers, and give them their hire, beginning from the last unto the first.
- Matthew 20:23 And he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.
- Matthew 21:37 But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son.
- Matthew 22:2 The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son,
- Matthew 22:44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I
 make thine enemies thy footstool?
- **Matthew 23:39** For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- Matthew 24:36 But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.
- **Matthew 25:34** Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:
- **Matthew 26:29** But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.
- **Matthew 26:39** And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou *wilt*.
- **Matthew 26:42** He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Matthew 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

- **Matthew 26:64** Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Matthew 27:43 He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God.
- Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- **Matthew 27:54** Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

Mark (19 / 678 verses - 2.8%)

- Mark 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- **Mark 1:11** And there came a voice from heaven, *saying*, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Mark 1:24 Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.
- Mark 3:11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the Son of God.
- Mark 5:7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee,
 Jesus, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment
 me not.
- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this
 adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed,
 when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.
- Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out
 of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.
- **Mark 9:37** Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.
- **Mark 11:9** And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord:
- **Mark 12:6** Having yet therefore one son, his wellbeloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will reverence my son.
- Mark 12:36 For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- **Mark 13:32** But of that day and *that* hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

- Mark 14:25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.
- Mark 14:36 And he said, Abba, Father, all things are possible unto thee; take
 away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt.
- **Mark 14:61** But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?
- **Mark 14:62** And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Mark 15:34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- Mark 15:39 And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he
 so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.
- Mark 16:19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

Luke (29 / 1,151 verses - 2.5%)

- Luke 1:32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
- **Luke 1:35** And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.
- Luke 2:49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I
 must be about my Father's business?
- Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
- Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.
- **Luke 4:3** And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread.
- Luke 4:9 And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence:
- **Luke 4:41** And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking *them* suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

- **Luke 8:28** When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of God most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.
- Luke 9:20 He said unto them, But whom say ye that I am? Peter answering said, The Christ of God.
- **Luke 9:26** For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and *in his* Father's, and of the holy angels.
- Luke 9:35 And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.
- **Luke 9:48** And said unto them, Whosoever shall receive this child in my name receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me receiveth him that sent me: for he that is least among you all, the same shall be great.
- **Luke 10:16** He that heareth you heareth me; and he that despiseth you despiseth me; and he that despiseth me despiseth him that sent me.
- **Luke 10:21** In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.
- **Luke 10:22** All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and *he* to whom the Son will reveal *him*.
- **Luke 13:35** Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until *the time* come when ye shall say, Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- **Luke 19:38** Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.
- **Luke 20:13** Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will reverence *him* when they see him.
- Luke 20:42 And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,
- Luke 22:16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 22:18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.
- Luke 22:29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;
- **Luke 22:42** Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

- Luke 22:70 Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, Ye say that I am.
- **Luke 23:34** Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
- Luke 24:19 And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:
- **Luke 24:49** And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

John (162 / 879 verses - 18.4%)

- **John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- John 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.
- **John 1:3** All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.
- **John 1:12** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:
- John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- John 1:18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is
 in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.
- **John 1:29** The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.
- John 1:34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.
- John 1:36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!
- **John 1:49** Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel.
- **John 3:2** The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.
- **John 3:11** Verily, verily, I say unto thee, We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness.
- **John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

- **John 3:17** For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- John 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not
 is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only
 begotten Son of God.
- **John 3:35** The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand.
- **John 3:36** He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.
- **John 4:34** Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.
- **John 5:17** But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.
- John 5:18 Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.
- **John 5:19** Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.
- John 5:20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.
- **John 5:21** For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth *them*; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.
- **John 5:22** For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- **John 5:23** That all *men* should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.
- **John 5:26** For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
- John 5:30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my
 judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father
 which hath sent me.
- **John 5:32** There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.
- **John 5:36** But I have greater witness than *that* of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.
- **John 5:37** And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.

- **John 5:38** And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not.
- **John 5:43** I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.
- **John 5:45** Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is *one* that accuseth you, *even* Moses, in whom ye trust.
- **John 6:27** Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.
- **John 6:29** Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- **John 6:32** Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.
- **John 6:33** For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.
- **John 6:37** All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.
- John 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- **John 6:39** And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- **John 6:40** And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- **John 6:44** No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- John 6:45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every
 man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.
- **John 6:46** Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.
- **John 6:57** As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.
- John 6:65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.
- John 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.
- John 7:16 Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.

- **John 7:17** If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or *whether* I speak of myself.
- John 7:18 He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.
- **John 7:28** Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not.
- **John 7:29** But I know him: for I am from him, and he hath sent me.
- **John 7:33** Then said Jesus unto them, Yet a little while am I with you, and *then* I go unto him that sent me.
- **John 8:16** And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me.
- **John 8:18** I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.
- **John 8:19** Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.
- **John 8:26** I have many things to say and to judge of you: but he that sent me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of him.
- John 8:27 They understood not that he spake to them of the Father.
- **John 8:28** Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am *he*, and *that* I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.
- **John 8:29** And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.
- **John 8:38** I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.
- John 8:40 But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I
 have heard of God: this did not Abraham.
- **John 8:42** Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.
- **John 8:49** Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.
- John 8:50 And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth.
- **John 8:54** Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:
- John 8:55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.

- **John 9:4** I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- John 9:35 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God?
- **John 10:15** As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.
- John 10:17 Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I
 might take it again.
- John 10:18 No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.
- **John 10:25** Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.
- **John 10:29** My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.
- John 10:30 I and my Father are one.
- John 10:32 Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me?
- John 10:36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?
- **John 10:37** If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.
- **John 10:38** But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father *is* in me, and I in him.
- **John 11:4** When Jesus heard *that,* he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.
- **John 11:22** But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give *it* thee.
- **John 11:27** She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.
- John 11:41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.
- **John 11:42** And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said *it*, that they may believe that thou hast sent me.
- **John 12:13** Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed *is* the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- **John 12:26** If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will *my* Father honour.
- **John 12:27** Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.

- **John 12:28** Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, *saying*, I have both glorified *it*, and will glorify *it* again.
- John 12:44 Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.
- **John 12:45** And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.
- **John 12:49** For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.
- John 12:50 And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.
- **John 13:1** Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.
- **John 13:3** Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;
- **John 13:20** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
- **John 13:31** Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.
- **John 13:32** If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify him in himself, and shall straightway glorify him.
- John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.
- **John 14:2** In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not *so,* I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- **John 14:7** If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.
- **John 14:9** Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father?
- **John 14:10** Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.
- **John 14:11** Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.
- **John 14:12** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
- **John 14:13** And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.
- John 14:20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

- **John 14:21** He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
- **John 14:23** Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.
- **John 14:24** He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.
- **John 14:28** Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come *again* unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I.
- **John 14:31** But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.
- **John 15:1** I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.
- **John 15:2** Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every *branch* that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
- John 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be
 my disciples.
- John 15:9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.
- **John 15:10** If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.
- **John 15:15** Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
- **John 15:16** Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.
- **John 15:21** But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me.
- John 15:23 He that hateth me hateth my Father also.
- **John 15:24** If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- **John 16:3** And these things will they do unto you, because they have not known the Father, nor me.
- **John 16:5** But now I go my way to him that sent me; and none of you asketh me, Whither goest thou?
- **John 16:10** Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more:

- **John 16:15** All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you.
- **John 16:16** A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.
- **John 16:17** Then said *some* of his disciples among themselves, What is this that he saith unto us, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me: and, Because I go to the Father?
- **John 16:23** And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give *it* you.
- **John 16:25** These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.
- **John 16:26** At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:
- **John 16:27** For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.
- John 16:28 I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.
- **John 16:30** Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: by this we believe that thou camest forth from God.
- **John 16:32** Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.
- **John 17:1** These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:
- **John 17:2** As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.
- **John 17:3** And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- John 17:4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou
 gavest me to do.
- **John 17:5** And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.
- **John 17:6** I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.
- John 17:7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.

- **John 17:8** For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.
- **John 17:9** I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.
- John 17:10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.
- **John 17:11** And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*.
- **John 17:12** While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- **John 17:13** And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.
- **John 17:14** I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- **John 17:15** I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
- **John 17:18** As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.
- **John 17:21** That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- **John 17:22** And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:
- John 17:23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- **John 17:24** Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.
- **John 17:25** O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
- **John 17:26** And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare *it:* that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.
- **John 18:11** Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?
- **John 19:7** The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law he ought to die, because he made himself the Son of God.

- John 20:17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.
- **John 20:21** Then said Jesus to them again, Peace *be* unto you: as *my* Father hath sent me, even so send I you.
- **John 20:31** But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

Acts (42 / 1,007 verses - 4.2%)

- **Acts 1:4** And, being assembled together with *them*, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, *saith he*, ye have heard of me.
- Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:
- Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:
- Acts 2:24 Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because
 it was not possible that he should be holden of it.
- Acts 2:25 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:
- Acts 2:27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- Acts 2:30 Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;
- Acts 2:32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.
- Acts 2:33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.
- Acts 2:34 For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,
- Acts 2:35 Until I make thy foes thy footstool.
- Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let *him* go.

- Acts 3:15 And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead;
 whereof we are witnesses.
- Acts 3:18 But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled.
- Acts 3:26 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.
- Acts 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.
- Acts 4:26 The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ.
- Acts 4:27 For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,
- Acts 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders
 may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.
- Acts 5:30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.
- Acts 5:31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.
- Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send *to be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.
- Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,
- Acts 7:56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.
- Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- Acts 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.
- Acts 9:20 And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.
- Acts 10:36 The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:)
- Acts 10:40 Him God raised up the third day, and shewed him openly;
- Acts 10:41 Not to all the people, but unto witnesses chosen before of God, even to us, who did eat and drink with him after he rose from the dead.

- Acts 10:42 And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was ordained of God *to be* the Judge of quick and dead.
- Acts 11:17 Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?
- Acts 13:23 Of this man's seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus:
- Acts 13:30 But God raised him from the dead:
- Acts 13:33 God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.
- Acts 13:37 But he, whom God raised again, saw no corruption.
- Acts 20:21 Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.
- Acts 22:14 And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou
 shouldest know his will, and see that Just One, and shouldest hear the voice of
 his mouth.
- Acts 28:23 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him
 into his lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God,
 persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the
 prophets, from morning till evening.
- Acts 28:31 Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

Romans (44 / 433 verses - 10.2%)

- Romans 1:1 Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called *to be* an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God,
- Romans 1:3 Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;
- Romans 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called *to be* saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Romans 1:8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.
- Romans 1:9 For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;

- Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.
- Romans 2:16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.
- **Romans 3:22** Even the righteousness of God *which is* by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:
- Romans 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:
- Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
- **Romans 3:26** To declare, *I say,* at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.
- Romans 4:24 But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;
- Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
- Romans 5:2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
- Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners. Christ died for us.
- Romans 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.
- Romans 5:11 And not only *so*, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.
- **Romans 5:15** But not as the offence, so also *is* the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, *which is* by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.
- Romans 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- Romans 6:10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.
- Romans 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- **Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- Romans 7:4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.
- Romans 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.
- Romans 8:3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:
- Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
- Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
- **Romans 8:17** And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with *him*, that we may be also glorified together.
- Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- Romans 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- **Romans 9:5** Whose *are* the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ *came*, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen.
- Romans 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
- Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.
- Romans 14:18 For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men.
- Romans 15:3 For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.
- Romans 15:5 Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus:
- Romans 15:6 That ye may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- Romans 15:7 Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God.
- **Romans 15:8** Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises *made* unto the fathers:
- Romans 15:17 I have therefore whereof I may glory through Jesus Christ in those things which pertain to God.
- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly.
 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- Romans 16:27 To God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen.

1 Corinthians (21 / 437 verses - 4.8%)

- 1 Corinthians 1:1 Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will
 of God, and Sosthenes our brother,
- **1 Corinthians 1:2** Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called *to be* saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
- **1 Corinthians 1:3** Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 1:4 I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;
- **1 Corinthians 1:9** God *is* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.
- **1 Corinthians 1:24** But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.
- **1 Corinthians 1:30** But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:
- 1 Corinthians 3:23 And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.
- 1 Corinthians 4:1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.
- **1 Corinthians 4:5** Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.
- **1 Corinthians 6:13** Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body *is* not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.
- 1 Corinthians 6:14 And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power.
- 1 Corinthians 7:17 But as God hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk. And so ordain I in all churches.

- **1 Corinthians 8:6** But to us *there is but* one God, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom *are* all things, and we by him.
- 1 Corinthians 9:21 To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law.
- **1 Corinthians 11:3** But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman *is* the man; and the head of Christ *is* God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:15 Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not.
- **1 Corinthians 15:24** Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.
- **1 Corinthians 15:27** For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under *him, it is* manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.
- 1 Corinthians 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.
- 1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians (25 / 257 verses - 9.7%)

- **2 Corinthians 1:1** Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy *our* brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia:
- **2 Corinthians 1:2** Grace *be* to you and peace from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **2 Corinthians 1:3** Blessed *be* God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;
- **2 Corinthians 1:19** For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us, *even* by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea.
- **2 Corinthians 1:20** For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.
- **2 Corinthians 1:21** Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, *is* God;

- **2 Corinthians 2:14** Now thanks *be* unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.
- **2 Corinthians 2:15** For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish:
- **2 Corinthians 2:17** For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
- **2 Corinthians 3:4** And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward:
- **2 Corinthians 4:4** In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- **2 Corinthians 4:6** For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
- **2 Corinthians 4:14** Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present *us* with you.
- 2 Corinthians 5:11 Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.
- **2 Corinthians 5:18** And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
- 2 Corinthians 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
- **2 Corinthians 5:20** Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.
- **2 Corinthians 5:21** For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- **2 Corinthians 8:5** And *this they did,* not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.
- 2 Corinthians 9:13 Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify
 God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal
 distribution unto them, and unto all men;
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that
 exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every
 thought to the obedience of Christ;
- **2 Corinthians 11:31** The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is blessed for evermore, knoweth that I lie not.

- **2 Corinthians 12:2** I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 12:19 Again, think ye that we excuse ourselves unto you? we speak before God in Christ: but we do all things, dearly beloved, for your edifying.
- **2 Corinthians 13:4** For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you.

Galatians (11 / 149 verses - 7.4%)

- **Galatians 1:1** Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)
- Galatians 1:3 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **Galatians 1:4** Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:
- **Galatians 1:10** For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.
- Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ
 liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son
 of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- **Galatians 2:21** I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.
- **Galatians 3:17** And this I say, *that* the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect.
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- **Galatians 4:4** But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
- **Galatians 4:6** And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- Galatians 4:7 Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Ephesians (26 / 155 verses - 16.8%)

• **Ephesians 1:1** Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:

- **Ephesians 1:2** Grace *be* to you, and peace, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Ephesians 1:3** Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:
- **Ephesians 1:5** Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- **Ephesians 1:6** To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.
- **Ephesians 1:10** That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:
- **Ephesians 1:17** That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:
- **Ephesians 1:20** Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the heavenly *places*,
- **Ephesians 2:5** Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
- **Ephesians 2:7** That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in *his* kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
- **Ephesians 2:10** For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
- **Ephesians 2:12** That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:
- **Ephesians 2:16** And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:
- **Ephesians 3:6** That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:
- **Ephesians 3:9** And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:
- **Ephesians 3:11** According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:
- **Ephesians 3:14** For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- **Ephesians 3:18** May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
- **Ephesians 3:21** Unto him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

- **Ephesians 4:13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:
- **Ephesians 4:32** And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
- **Ephesians 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.
- **Ephesians 5:5** For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
- Ephesians 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- **Ephesians 6:6** Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;
- **Ephesians 6:23** Peace *be* to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians (12 / 104 verses - 11.5%)

- **Philippians 1:2** Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a
 good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:
- Philippians 1:8 For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.
- **Philippians 1:11** Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
- **Philippians 2:6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
- **Philippians 2:9** Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:
- **Philippians 2:11** And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- **Philippians 3:9** And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:
- **Philippians 3:14** I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

- **Philippians 4:7** And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Colossians (15 / 95 verses - 15.8%)

- **Colossians 1:1** Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timotheus *our* brother.
- Colossians 1:2 To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Colossians 1:3** We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,
- **Colossians 1:15** Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:
- Colossians 1:19 For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;
- Colossians 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:
- Colossians 2:2 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;
- **Colossians 2:12** Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with *him* through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
- Colossians 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- Colossians 2:19 And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.
- Colossians 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.
- Colossians 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
- Colossians 4:3 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

• **Colossians 4:12** Epaphras, who is *one* of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

1 Thessalonians (13 / 89 verses - 14.6%)

- 1 Thessalonians 1:1 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father:
- **1 Thessalonians 1:10** And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, *even* Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.
- **1 Thessalonians 2:14** For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they *have* of the Jews:
- **1 Thessalonians 2:15** Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men:
- 1 Thessalonians 3:2 And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:
- 1 Thessalonians 3:11 Now God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you.
- **1 Thessalonians 3:13** To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.
- **1 Thessalonians 4:1** Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort *you* by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, *so* ye would abound more and more.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- **1 Thessalonians 5:23** And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians (7 / 47 verses - 14.9%)

- **2 Thessalonians 1:1** Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:
- 2 Thessalonians 1:2 Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:8 In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 2 Thessalonians 1:12 That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:16 Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,
- 2 Thessalonians 3:5 And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

1 Timothy (6 / 113 verses - 5.3%)

- 1 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope;
- **1 Timothy 1:2** Unto Timothy, *my* own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1 Timothy 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- **1 Timothy 5:21** I charge *thee* before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, and the elect angels, that thou observe these things without preferring one before another, doing nothing by partiality.
- 1 Timothy 6:13 I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

2 Timothy (7 / 83 verses - 8.4%)

- **2 Timothy 1:1** Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus,
- **2 Timothy 1:2** To Timothy, *my* dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

- **2 Timothy 1:8** Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;
- **2 Timothy 1:9** Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
- **2 Timothy 1:10** But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:
- **2 Timothy 2:19** Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.
- **2 Timothy 4:1** I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

Titus (4 / 46 verses - 8.7%)

- Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;
- Titus 1:4 To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.
- **Titus 2:13** Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
- Titus 3:6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

Philemon (1 / 25 verses - 4%)

• **Philemon 1:3** Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Hebrews (29 / 303 verses - 9.6%)

- Hebrews 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;
- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

- **Hebrews 1:5** For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son?
- **Hebrews 1:6** And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.
- **Hebrews 1:8** But unto the Son *he saith,* Thy throne, O God, *is* for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness *is* the sceptre of thy kingdom.
- Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore
 God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.
- **Hebrews 1:13** But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool?
- Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.
- **Hebrews 2:13** And again, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the children which God hath given me.
- Hebrews 2:17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.
- **Hebrews 4:14** Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* profession.
- Hebrews 5:5 So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee.
- **Hebrews 5:7** Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;
- Hebrews 5:10 Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.
- **Hebrews 6:1** Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God.
- Hebrews 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.
- **Hebrews 7:21** (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:)
- **Hebrews 7:25** Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

- **Hebrews 9:24** For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, *which are* the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:
- Hebrews 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.
- **Hebrews 10:9** Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.
- **Hebrews 10:10** By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all.*
- **Hebrews 10:12** But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;
- **Hebrews 10:21** And *having* an high priest over the house of God;
- **Hebrews 12:2** Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Hebrews 12:23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect.
- **Hebrews 13:15** By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name.
- Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
- **Hebrews 13:21** Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen.

James (1 / 108 verses - 0.9%)

• **James 1:1** James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

1 Peter (7 / 105 verses - 6.7%)

- **1 Peter 1:3** Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- 1 Peter 1:21 Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

- 1 Peter 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy
 priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
- **1 Peter 3:21** The like figure whereunto *even* baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- **1 Peter 3:22** Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.
- 1 Peter 4:11 If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man
 minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may
 be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and
 ever. Amen.
- **1 Peter 5:10** But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.

2 Peter (3 / 61 verses - 4.9%)

- 2 Peter 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that
 have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and
 our Saviour Jesus Christ:
- 2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord.
- **2 Peter 1:17** For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

1 John (20 / 105 verses - 19%)

- **1 John 1:3** That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.
- **1 John 1:7** But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- **1 John 2:1** My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- **1 John 2:22** Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.

- 1 John 2:24 Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.
- **1 John 3:8** He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- **1 John 3:23** And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.
- **1 John 4:9** In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.
- **1 John 4:10** Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.
- **1 John 4:14** And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son *to* be the Saviour of the world.
- **1 John 4:15** Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.
- **1 John 5:1** Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
- **1 John 5:5** Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
- **1 John 5:9** If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.
- **1 John 5:10** He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
- **1 John 5:11** And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
- **1 John 5:12** He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.
- **1 John 5:13** These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
- **1 John 5:20** And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

2 John (2 / 13 verses - 15.3%)

• **2 John 1:3** Grace be with you, mercy, *and* peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

• **2 John 1:9** Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

Jude (3 / 25 verses - 12%)

- **Jude 1:1** Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, *and* called:
- **Jude 1:4** For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Jude 1:21** Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Revelation (36 / 404 verses - 8.9%)

- **Revelation 1:1** The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:
- Revelation 1:2 Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.
- **Revelation 1:6** And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
- **Revelation 1:9** I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Revelation 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;
- Revelation 2:27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a
 potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
- Revelation 3:2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.
- Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment;
 and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.
- **Revelation 3:12** Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.

- Revelation 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write;
 These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

[Father & Son] 11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; **12** Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. [Son] 13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. [Father & Son] 14 And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever. [Father]
- Revelation 7:9-17 After this I beheld, and, Io, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; [Son] 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. [Father & Son] 11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, [Father] 12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. [Father] 13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? 14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

- [Son] **15** Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. [Father] **16** They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. **17** For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. [Father & Son]
- Revelation 22:1-7 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. [Father & Son] 2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. 3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: [Father & Son] 4 And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. [Father] 5 And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. [Father] 6 And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done. [Father] 7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book. [Son]
- **Revelation 22:12-21** And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. [Son] 13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. [Father] **14** Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. **15** For without *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie. 16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. [Son] 17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely. 18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: [Father] 19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. [Father] 20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus. [Son] 21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. [Son]
