

All the World (and the Church) Wondered After the Beast

See **Revelation 13:3, 11-12, Matthew 22:36-40, and 1 Corinthians 10:11**

Adam and Eve - all the world, which was the church, wondered after the beast

- **Genesis 3**, no other gods...

Noah - nearly all the world wondered after the beast

- **Genesis 6, Matthew 24:37**, no other gods, coveting,

Sodom and Gomorrha - nearly all the city wondered after the beast

- **Genesis 18-19, Luke 17:28-29**, no other gods, adultery, covet, kill

Joshua and Caleb - nearly all the church wondered after the beast

- **Numbers 13-14**, no other gods

Israel - nearly all the church wondered after the beast

- **Jeremiah 5-6**, no other gods

Judah - nearly all the church wondered after the beast

- **Ezekiel 8-9**, no other gods

Elijah and the 7,000 - nearly all the world wondered after the beast

- **1 Kings 19:18, Romans 11:4**, no other gods

The three Hebrews - nearly all the world wondered after the beast

- **Daniel 3** - No other gods, idols - “make no law respecting an establishment of religion”

Daniel - nearly all the world wondered after the beast

- **Daniel 6** - No other gods - “prohibiting the free exercise thereof”

Israel in Christ's day - nearly all the world wondered after the beast

- **John 19:15**, no other gods

Revelation 13:1-18 - all the world wandered after the beast and its image

- No other gods, idols, bear false witness, covet
- See **Revelation 14:12**
