God in Loma Linda

The God of Abraham

Genesis 26:24 And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I *am* the **God of Abraham** thy father: fear not, for I *am* with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Genesis 28:13 And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I *am* the LORD **God of Abraham** thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

Genesis 31:42 Except the God of my father, the **God of Abraham**, and the fear of Isaac, had been with me, surely thou hadst sent me away now empty. God hath seen mine affliction and the labour of my hands, and rebuked *thee* yesternight.

Genesis 31:53 The **God of Abraham**, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Exodus 3:6 Moreover he said, I *am* the God of thy father, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 3:15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this *is* my name for ever, and this *is* my memorial unto all generations. **Exodus 3:16** Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the **God of Abraham**, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying,

I have surely visited you, and *seen* that which is done to you in Egypt:

Exodus 4:5 That they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers, the **God of Abraham**, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee.

1Kings 18:36 And it came to pass at *the time of* the offering of the *evening* sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou *art* God in Israel, and *that* I *am* thy servant, and *that* I have done all these things at thy word.

1Chronicles 29:18 O LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

2Chronicles 30:6 So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye

children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD **God of Abraham**, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Psalms 47:9 The princes of the people are gathered together, *even* the people of the **God of Abraham**: for the shields of the earth *belong* unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Matthew 22:32 I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

Mark 12:26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I *am* the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

Luke 20:37 Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the **God of Abraham**, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let *him* go.

Acts 7:32 *Saying*, I *am* the God of thy fathers, the **God of** Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Most High God

Genesis 14:18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he *was* the priest of the **most high God**.

Genesis 14:19 And he blessed him, and said, Blessed *be* Abram of the **most high God**, possessor of heaven and earth: **Genesis 14:20** And blessed be the **most high God**, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.

Genesis 14:22 And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the LORD, the **most high God**, the possessor of heaven and earth,

Psalms 78:56 Yet they tempted and provoked the **most high God**, and kept not his testimonies:

Daniel 3:26 Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, *and* spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the **most high God**, come forth, and come *hither*. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

Daniel 5:18 O thou king, the **most high God** gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honour:

Daniel 5:21 And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling *was* with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he knew that the **most high God** ruled in the kingdom of men, and *that* he appointeth over it whomsoever he will.

Mark 5:7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of the **most high God**? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.

Acts 16:17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the **most high God**, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

Hebrews 7:1 For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

Proverbs 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all

the ends of the earth? what *is* his name, and what *is* his son's name, if thou canst tell?

Malachi 2:10 Have we not all one father? hath not one God created us? ...

Ephesians 3:7 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.

Ephesians 3:8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

Ephesians 3:9 And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

Ephesians 3:10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly *places* might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

Ephesians 3:11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hebrews 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by *his* Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *his* glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the

word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.
