What About "the Beginning"?

Proverbs 8:22 The LORD possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old.

Proverbs 8:23 I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.

Proverbs 8:24 When *there were* no depths, I was brought forth; when *there were* no fountains abounding with water.

Revelation 1:4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

Revelation 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Christ and the Father are One!

John 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand.

John 10:29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.

John 10:30 I and my Father are one.

John 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

The Admission that Led to Death

Because of the Angels

Consider first Corinthians 11:

Christ has a head – He is under the authority of His Father.

Man has a head – he is under the authority of Christ.

Woman has a head – she is under the authority of her husband.

Why?

Because of the angels.

Really?

Why???

Because the faithful angels didn't know what had happened in the conflict over the begotten Son of God and the honored created son of God: Christ and Lucifer. They needed to understand what had happened and what the difference was between God the Father and His Son, so God made Adam to represent Himself, while Eve, begotten from Adam's own substance, represented the Son.

- Eve was **from** the man -Gen. 2:22, John 7:29, 8:42, 16:27-30, 17:8
- Eve was made/formed of the same **substance** -Gen.2:22, Phi. 2:5-7
- Eve was the **glory** of the **man** -1 Cor. 11:7, John 17:5
- Adam declared Eve as **equal**, 'bone/flesh' -Gen. 2:23, John 5:18
- Eve was a **help meet** (fit) for Adam -Gen.2:20, Zec. 6:13
- Eve was "the only being" good for Adam -Gen. 2:20-24
- Adam gave her a **name** -Gen. 2:23, Heb. 1:4-8
- Adam, as most men, was **taller** and **elder** -John 14:28, Romans 9:12
- Adam and Eve were "one" -Gen. 2:24, John 10:30
- They were "little short of being identical" -Gen. 2:23
