## Should We Talk of Clouds?

**Psalms 104:3** Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh **the clouds his chariot**: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

- **Psalms 68:17** The **chariots of God** are twenty thousand, even thousands of **angels**: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.

**Psalms 18:9** He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness was under his feet.

**Psalms 18:10** And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

**Job 40:9** Hast thou an arm like God? or canst thou **thunder with a voice** like him?

## Should We Talk of Lightning?

**Ezekiel 1:13** As for the likeness of the **living creatures**, their appearance *was* like burning coals of fire, *and* like the appearance of **lamps**: it went up and down among the living creatures; and the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth **lightning**.

**Ezekiel 1:14** And the living creatures **ran and returned** as the appearance of a flash of **lightning**.

**Matthew 28:3** His countenance was like **lightning**, and his raiment white as snow:

**Luke 10:18** And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as **lightning** fall from heaven.

## Query: I will Pour Out

**Proverbs 1:23** Turn you at my reproof: behold, **I will pour out my spirit** unto you, I will **make known my words** unto you.

- **Galatians 3:5** He therefore that **ministereth to you the Spirit**, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

**Ezekiel 20:8** But they **rebelled** against me, and **would not hearken** unto me: they did not every man cast away the **abominations** of their eyes, neither did they forsake the **idols** of Egypt: then I said, **I will pour out my fury** upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

- **Revelation 16:1** I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the **seven angels**, Go your ways, and **pour out the vials of the wrath** of God upon the earth.

**Ezekiel 21:31** And **I will pour out mine indignation** upon thee, I will blow against thee in the fire of my **wrath**, and deliver thee into the hand of brutish men, *and* skilful to destroy.

**Hosea 5:10** The princes of Judah were like them that remove the bound: *therefore* **I will pour out my wrath** upon them **like water**.

**Joel 2:28** And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* **I will pour out my spirit** upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall **prophesy**, your old men shall dream **dreams**, your young men shall see **visions**:

- **Revelation 22:8** And I John **saw** these things, and **heard** them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the **angel which shewed me** these things.  
**Revelation 22:9** Then saith he unto me, **See thou do it not**: for I am thy **fellow servant**, and of thy **brethren** the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: **worship God**.

**Acts 2:17** And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, **I will pour out of my Spirit** upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall **prophesy**, and your young men shall see **visions**, and your old men shall dream **dreams**:

**Acts 2:18** And on my servants and on my handmaidens **I will pour out** in those days of my **Spirit**; and they shall **prophesy**:

## Query: Latter Rain

**Deuteronomy 11:13** And it shall come to pass, if ye shall **hearken diligently unto my commandments** which I command you this day, to **love the LORD your God**, and to **serve him** with all your heart and with all your soul,

**Deuteronomy 11:14** That **I will give you the rain** of your land in his due season, the **first** rain and the **latter** rain, that thou mayest **gather in** thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil.

**Job 29:21** Unto me *men* gave ear, and **waited**, and **kept silence** at my **counsel**.

**Job 29:22** After **my words** they spake not again; and **my speech dropped** upon them.

**Job 29:23** And they **waited** for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide *as* for the latter rain.

- **Deuteronomy 32:1** Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and **hear**, O earth, the **words** of my mouth.

**Deuteronomy 32:2** My **doctrine shall drop as the rain**, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the **small rain** upon the tender **herb**, and as the **showers** upon the **grass**:

**Proverbs 16:14** The **wrath** of a king *is as* **messengers** of death: but a wise man will pacify it.

**Proverbs 16:15** In the **light** of the king's **countenance** *is* life; and his **favour** *is* as a **cloud** of the latter rain.

**Jeremiah 3:1** They say, If a man put away his **wife**, and she go from him, and **become another man's**, shall he **return** unto her again? shall not that land be greatly **polluted**? but thou hast played the **harlot with many lovers**; **yet return again** to me, saith the LORD.

**Jeremiah 3:2** Lift up thine eyes unto the high places, and see where thou hast **not been** lien with. In the ways hast thou sat for them, as the Arabian in the wilderness; and thou hast polluted the land with thy **whoredoms** and with thy **wickedness**.

**Jeremiah 3:3** Therefore the **showers** have been **withholden**, and there hath been **no latter rain**; and thou hadst a **whore's forehead**, thou **refusedst to be ashamed**.

**Jeremiah 5:20** **Declare** this in the house of Jacob, and **publish** it in Judah, saying,

**Jeremiah 5:21** **Hear** now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not:

**Jeremiah 5:22** Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand *for* the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?

**Jeremiah 5:23** But this people hath a **revolting** and a **rebellious** heart; they are revolted and gone.

**Jeremiah 5:24** Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the **LORD our God, that giveth rain**, both the **former** and the **latter**, in his season: he reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest.

**Jeremiah 5:25** ¶ Your **iniquities** have turned away these *things*, and your **sins** have withholden good *things* from you.

**Hosea 6:1** ¶ Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath **torn**, and he will **heal** us; he hath **smitten**, and he will **bind** us up.

**Hosea 6:2** After two days will he revive us: in the **third day** he will **raise us up**, and **we shall live** in his sight.

**Hosea 6:3** Then shall we **know**, *if* we follow on to **know the LORD**: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and **he shall come** unto us as the rain, as the **latter and former** rain unto the earth.

- **Acts 3:19 Repent** ye therefore, and be **converted**, that your sins may be blotted out, when the **times of refreshing** shall come from the presence of the Lord;  
**Acts 3:20** And **he shall send Jesus Christ**, which before was preached unto you:

**Joel 2:21** Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things.

**Joel 2:22** Be not afraid, ye beasts of the field: for the pastures of the wilderness do spring, for the tree beareth her fruit, the fig tree and the vine do yield their strength.

**Joel 2:23** Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the **former rain moderately**, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the **latter rain** in the first *month*.

**Zechariah 10:1** Ask ye of the LORD rain in the **time** of the latter rain; *so* the LORD shall make **bright clouds**, and **give them showers** of rain, to every one grass in the field.

**Zechariah 10:2** For the **idols** have spoken vanity, and the **diviners** have seen a lie, and have told false **dreams**; they **comfort** in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because *there was* no shepherd.

**Zechariah 10:3** Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for **the LORD of hosts hath visited** his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

**James 5:5** Ye have lived in **pleasure** on the earth, and been **wanton**; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.

**James 5:6** Ye have **condemned and killed** the just; *and* he doth not resist you.

**James 5:7** Be **patient** therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the **early and latter rain**.

**James 5:8** Be ye also **patient; stablish** your **hearts**: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.

**James 5:9** Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, **the judge standeth before the door**.
