Latter Rain

Should We Talk of Clouds?

Psalms 104:3 Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh **the clouds his chariot**: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

• Psalms 68:17 The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.

Should We Talk of Wind?

Psalms 18:9 He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness was under his feet. Psalms 18:10 And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

Should We Talk of Thunder?

Job 40:9 Hast thou an arm like God? or canst thou **thunder with a voice** like him?

Should We Talk of Lightning?

Ezekiel 1:13 As for the likeness of the **living creatures**, their appearance *was* like burning coals of **fire**, *and* like the appearance of **lamps**: it went up and down among the living creatures; and the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth **lightning**.

Ezekiel 1:14 And the living creatures ran and returned as the appearance of a flash of lightning.

Matthew 28:3 His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow:

Luke 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as **lightning** fall from heaven.

Query: I will Pour Out

Proverbs 1:23 Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

• Galatians 3:5 He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Ezekiel 20:8 But they **rebelled** against me, and **would not hearken** unto me: they did not every man cast away the **abominations** of their eyes, neither did they forsake the **idols** of Egypt: then I said, **I will pour out my fury** upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

• **Revelation 16:1** I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the **seven angels**, Go your ways, and **pour out the vials of the wrath** of God upon the earth.

Ezekiel 21:31 And I will pour out mine indignation upon thee, I will blow against thee in the fire of my wrath, and deliver thee into the hand of brutish men, and skilful to destroy.

Hosea 5:10 The princes of Judah were like them that remove the bound: therefore I will pour out my wrath upon them like water.

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* **I will pour out my spirit** upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall **prophesy**, your old men shall dream **dreams**, your young men shall see **visions**:

• **Revelation 22:8** And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.

Revelation 22:9 Then saith he unto me, **See** *thou do it* **not**: for I am thy **fellowservant**, and of thy **brethren** the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: **worship God**.

Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

Acts 2:18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens **I will pour out** in those days of my **Spirit**; and they shall **prophesy**:

Query: Latter Rain

Deuteronomy 11:13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall **hearken diligently unto my commandments** which I command you this day, to **love the LORD your God**, and to **serve him** with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy 11:14 That **I will give** *you* **the rain** of your land in his due season, the **first** rain and the **latter** rain, that thou mayest **gather in** thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil.

Job 29:21 Unto me *men* gave ear, and waited, and kept silence at my counsel.

Job 29:22 After my words they spake not again; and my speech dropped upon them.

Job 29:23 And they **waited** for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide *as* for the latter rain.

• **Deuteronomy 32:1 Give ear**, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and **hear**, O earth, the **words** of my mouth.

Deuteronomy 32:2 My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the **small rain** upon the tender **herb**, and as the **showers** upon the **grass**:

Proverbs 16:14 The **wrath** of a king *is as* **messengers** of death: but a wise man will pacify it. **Proverbs 16:15** In the **light** of the king's **countenance** *is* life; and his **favour** *is* as a **cloud** of the latter rain

Jeremiah 3:1 They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many lovers; yet return again to me, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 3:2 Lift up thine eyes unto the high places, and see where thou hast **not been** lien with. In the ways hast thou sat for them, as the Arabian in the wilderness; and thou hast polluted the land with thy **whoredoms** and with thy **wickedness**.

Jeremiah 3:3 Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.

Jeremiah 5:20 Declare this in the house of Jacob, and publish it in Judah, saying,

Jeremiah 5:21 Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not:

Jeremiah 5:22 Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand *for* the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?

Jeremiah 5:23 But this people hath a **revolting** and a **rebellious** heart; they are revolted and gone.

Jeremiah 5:24 Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: he reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest.

Jeremiah 5:25 ¶ Your **iniquities** have turned away these *things*, and your **sins** have withholden good *things* from you.

Hosea 6:1 ¶ Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath **torn**, and he will **heal** us; he hath **smitten**, and he will **bind** us up.

Hosea 6:2 After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

Hosea 6:3 Then shall we **know**, *if* we follow on to **know the LORD**: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and **he shall come** unto us as the rain, as the **latter** *and* **former** rain unto the earth.

• Acts 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; Acts 3:20 And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you:

Joel 2:21 Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things.

Joel 2:22 Be not afraid, ye beasts of the field: for the pastures of the wilderness do spring, for the tree beareth her fruit, the fig tree and the vine do yield their strength.

Joel 2:23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the **former rain moderately**, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the **latter rain** in the first *month*.

Zechariah 10:1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the **time** of the latter rain; *so* the LORD shall make **bright clouds**, and **give them showers** of rain, to every one grass in the field.

Zechariah 10:2 For the **idols** have spoken vanity, and the **diviners** have seen a lie, and have told false **dreams**; they **comfort** in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because *there was* no shepherd.

Zechariah 10:3 Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for **the LORD of hosts hath visited** his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

James 5:5 Ye have lived in **pleasure** on the earth, and been **wanton**; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.

James 5:6 Ye have condemned and killed the just; and he doth not resist you.

James 5:7 Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

James 5:8 Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. James 5:9 Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door.
