# **Totally Stuck by My Truck!**

My truck is such a blessing! So thankful... Also, Pastor Allen Stump just stopped me the last day of camp meeting and said something like, "Just about a month ago I joined the truck club!" He was telling me about his used Ram truck that he was just able to 'pick up.' Excuse the pun.

My truck that God provided is bare bones. It's an F250 to pull stuff, but no automatic windows, door locks, etc. Well, I decided I wanted at least to have a key fob for the doors to automatically open from the outside, so my friend Matt gave me directions on how to do that. Scott lives close enough to help and is also electrically inclined, so he came over. We got most of it installed in two afternoons and then it was my turn to finish the project the next sunshiny morning.

I knew the passenger door had to come off in this situation, so I put a ratchet strap around the bottom of the door and with the window down put the strap through the window frame. Then I put the strap over my shoulder and neck so I could keep the door from falling strait to the ground when I unbolted it from the chassis. The last of the three bolts were out, and just as expected the door came down a few inches and was caught by the strap around my neck. As I was starting to move the door away from the truck to set it down on the ground I realized... "Oh NO!" The electrical cable, which was REALLY difficult to get off on the driver's side, was still connected!

Ugh... I had prepared to take the door off, but I had NOT prepared myself to put it back on, as I didn't think I would need to until later! Wow... I was truly stuck... There's a full sized truck door around my neck, my phone is out of reach, my tools were close enough to get, yet I'm holding the door, and if I let this door down, the wires would be pulled, extended, stretched, broken, etc! Now what?

I was already praying, and started trying to figure out how to get my tools to get the first bolt back into the door... The door was now resting on my right leg, but slipping because of the angle. It hurt because of the pressure points into my leg muscles... I never bruise, but had four big ones after that experience! One hand could finally let go to grab the first bolt. I put the bolt near the location of it's origin, but couldn't quite see it because of the angle... I then noticed the door hinge was facing the wrong direction, so trying to get the hinge the right way I dropped the

bolt on the ground. UGH! Getting the other bolt in my left hand I immediately dropped that one too! The third bolt wouldn't help in this situation, so now what...?

The door was now digging into my right leg even more, so I bent my left leg down to a kneeling position—good place to be when you're stuck, right?—and was able to get one of the bolts with as much stretch as humanly possible.

Didn't I mention that the sun was out? It was hot... I was sweating like I was in a shower. The flies were landing on my lower legs, my back, my head, my face... and I HATE flies... LOL! I felt like I couldn't do much more but to keep the door up by my leg, the left side of my neck by the strap, and my right shoulder which was being bloodied by the exposed door frame as the door panel was already off... The whole experience was ugly.

That bolt didn't get into that door until after a full hour! I wasn't able to give up, I couldn't! I was stuck! Either I did this or I would have to go through a very big hassle in replacing what would be broken, and that was not an option. So... I kept praying and persevering with what seemed like ages, and FINALLY! It happened. The bolt that I could not get into the right position finally lined up. W.H.E.W...

"Here is the patience of the saints..." Revelation 14:12. Even through all of that trial, I never submitted to giving in or giving up. There were times in that hour of trial that I wanted to let go, I wanted to be done, I wanted to quit, I was exhausted, but I couldn't. There was too much at stake. Isn't that a fraction of how it's going to be (times one thousand) when Jacob's trouble is upon us? We will need to just keep moving forward by God's grace through faith, keeping hold of Bible promises and pushing on till the completion of His plan for us. When you're walking through the valley of the shadow of death, keep walking!
